Caucasus Barometer 2011 Results Coming Soon!

The Caucasus Barometer 2010 will be available shortly! The Caucasus Barometer (CB) is our annual nationwide survey conducted in Armenia, Georgia and Azerbaijan since 2004. It explores the social, political and economic dynamics in these three countries and offers comparative data on individual and household knowledge, attitudes and practices. In addition to the questions asked in previous rounds, CRRC has included new questions assessing employment, gender issues and religion in the Caucasus. The 2010 survey also included specific questions concerning Armenia-Turkey relations and Georgia-Abkhazia concerns. [Read more...](#)
