

South Caucasus Caucasus Barometer 2012



Methodology


- Over 2,000 people in each South Caucasus country (a total of 6,715 respondents)
- Representative of total adult (18+) population
- Proportional representation of demographic and geographic groups
- Multi-stage cluster sampling, sampling error is ± 1.4%
- Household selection: Random walk method
- Respondent selection: Kish table
- Face-to-face interviews in local languages
- Survey period: October to November, 2012




P1. Direction the country's domestic politics are going. (%) (CB 2012)






P5. What is the most important issue facing your country at the moment? (%) (CB 2012)














P9. Under the present government in your country, how much do you agree that people like yourself are treated fairly by the government? (%) (CB 2012)

P9. Under the current government, how much do you agree that people like yourself are treated fairly by the government? (%) (CB 2010-2012)




P15. How much do you agree in the follwoing statements? (%)

Statement 2: People should not participate in protest actions against the government, as it threatens stability in our country.





P10. Do people like yourself have the right to openly say what they think in your country today? (%) (CB 2012)




P2. How well do TV journalists in your country inform the population about what is actually going on in the country?






ST1. Which of the words best describes your attitude towards Stalin? (%) (CB 2012)




ST2. Would you like to live and work in a country ruled by a person like Stalin? (%)












D15. If you had a chance, would you leave your country for a certain period of time to live somewhere else? (%)











C8. Household's spending last month. (%) (CB 2012)



D4. Frequency of internet use (%) (CB 2012)




D3. Level of Ability in Russian, English and using a Computer (%) (CB 2012)


N9. Approve or disapprove of people of your ethnicity doing business with Russians? (%)












G1. To which degree would you support the opening of the ArmenianTurkish border without any preconditions? (%)









