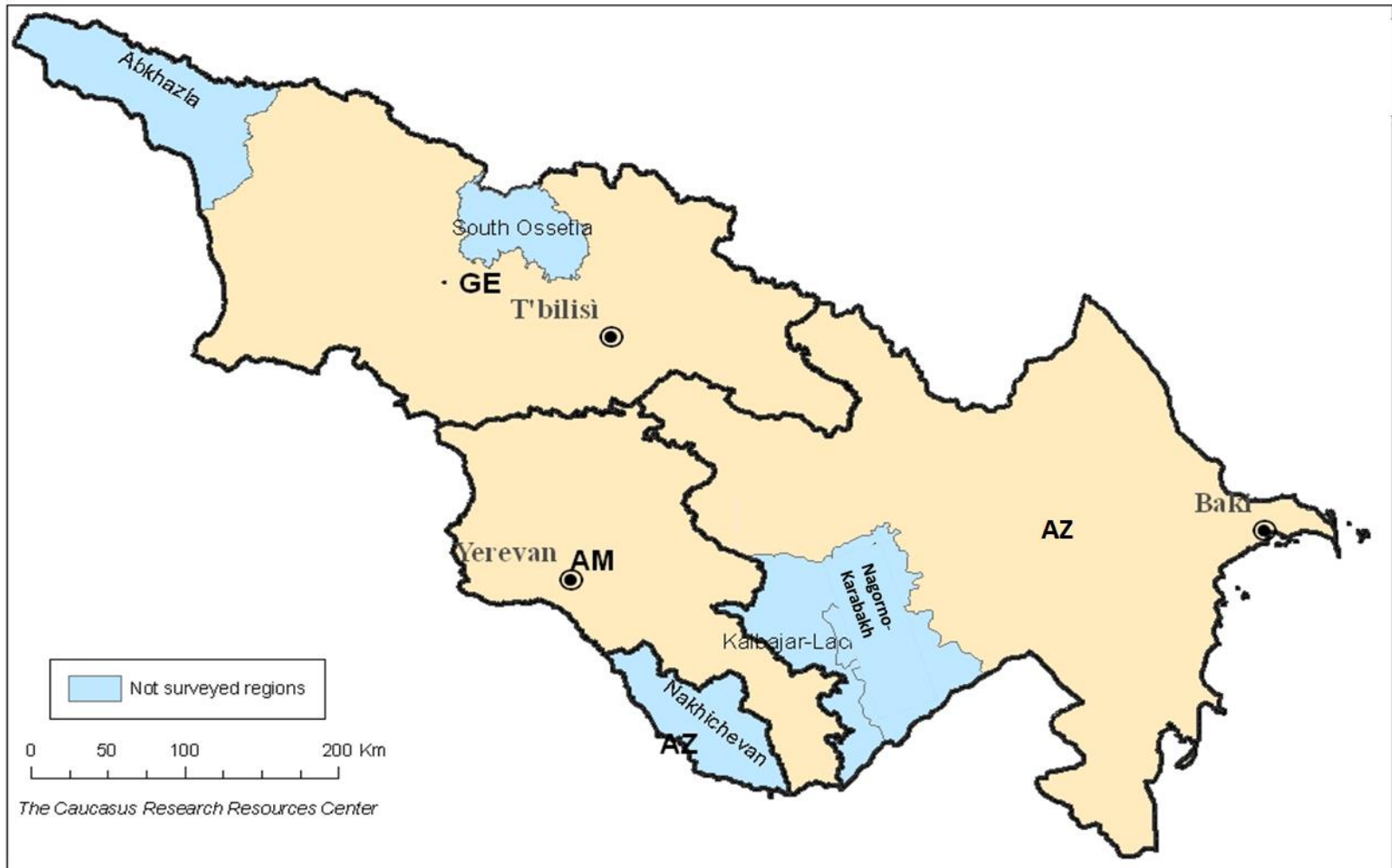

Where We Survey



Methodology

- Over 2,000 people in each South Caucasus country
- Representative of total adult (18+) population
- Proportional representation of demographic and geographic groups
- Multi-stage cluster sampling, sampling error is $\pm 2.3\%$
- Household selection: Random walk method
- Respondent selection: Kish table
- Face-to-face interviews in local languages

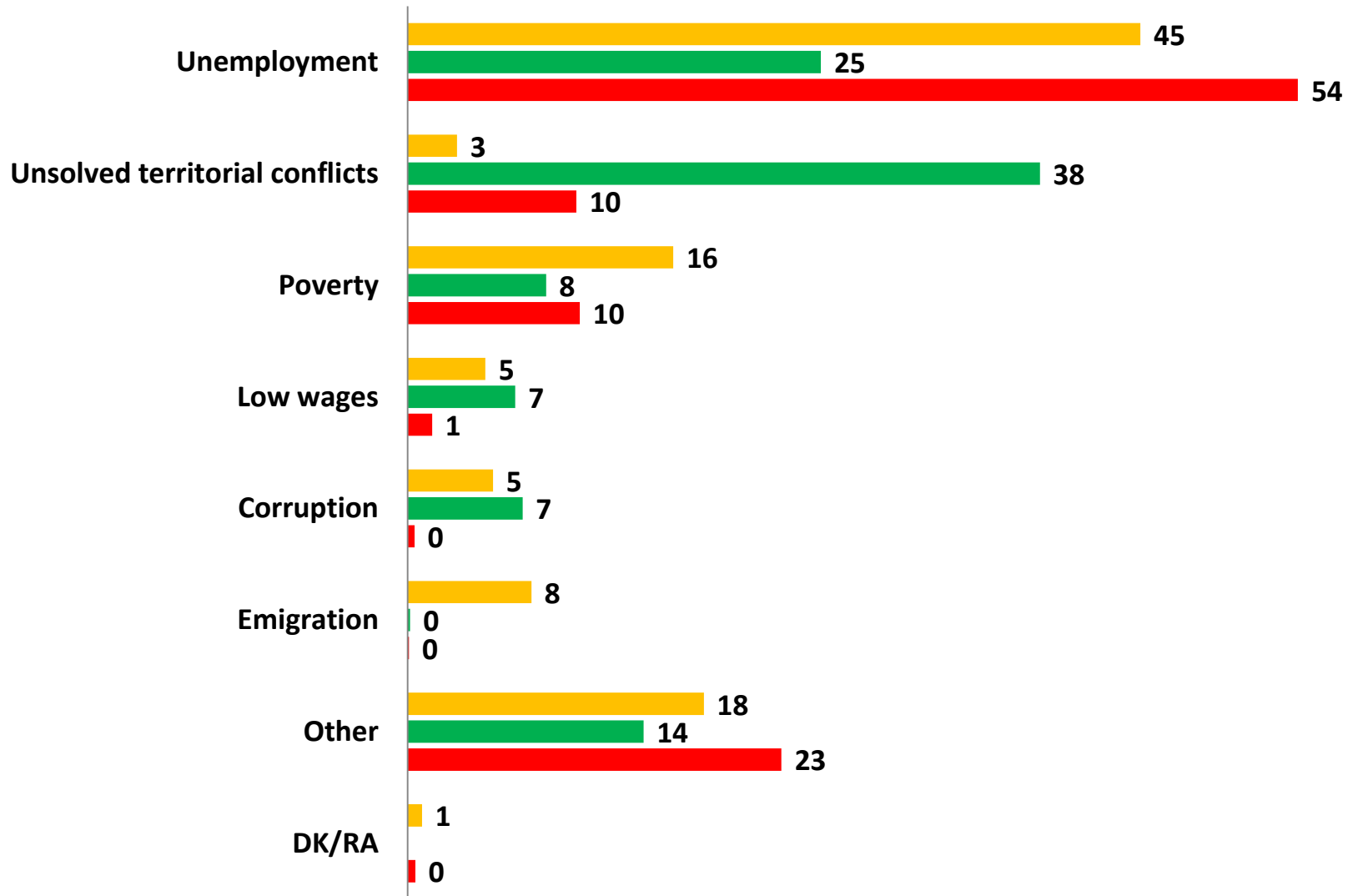
Content

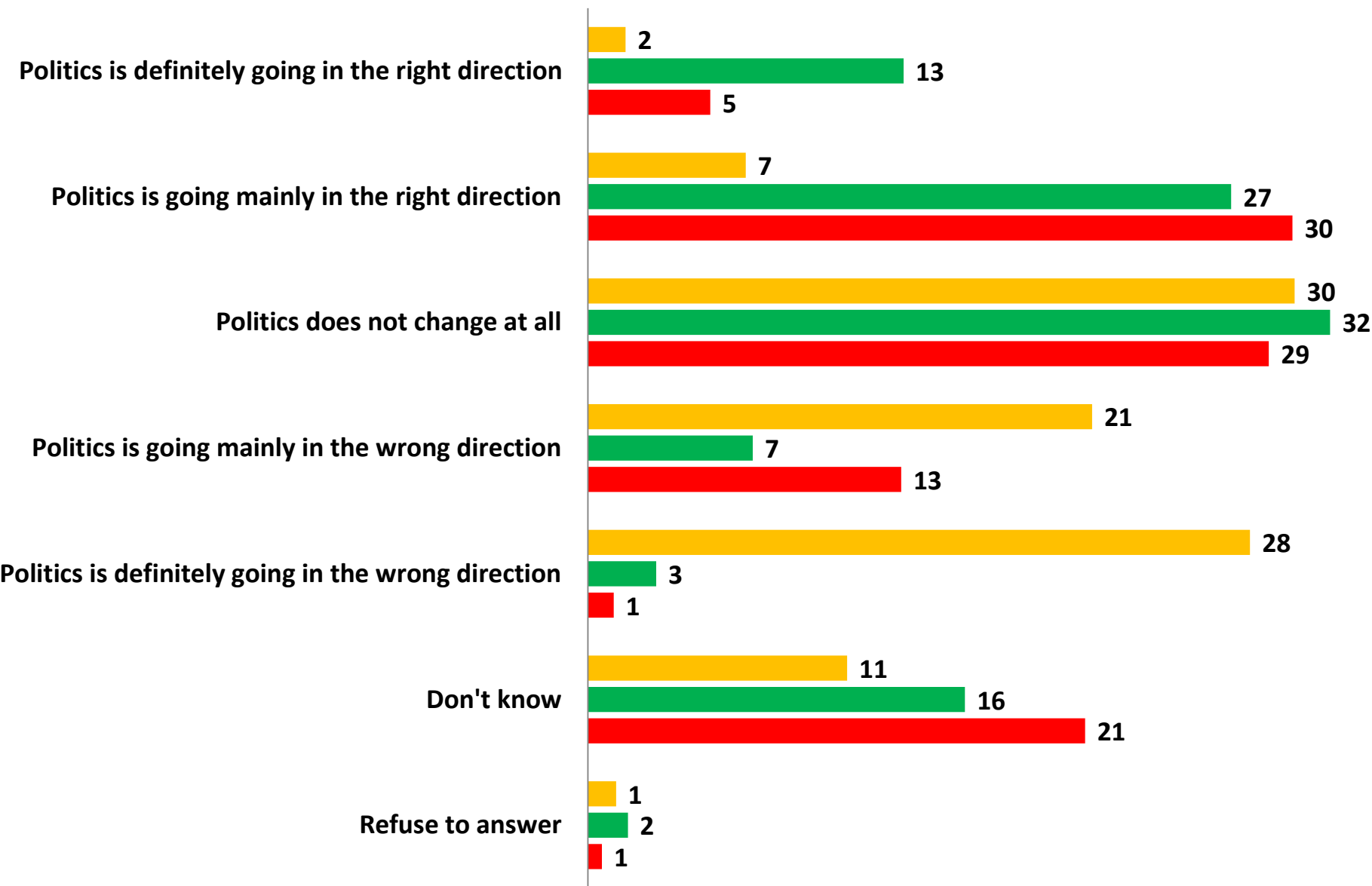

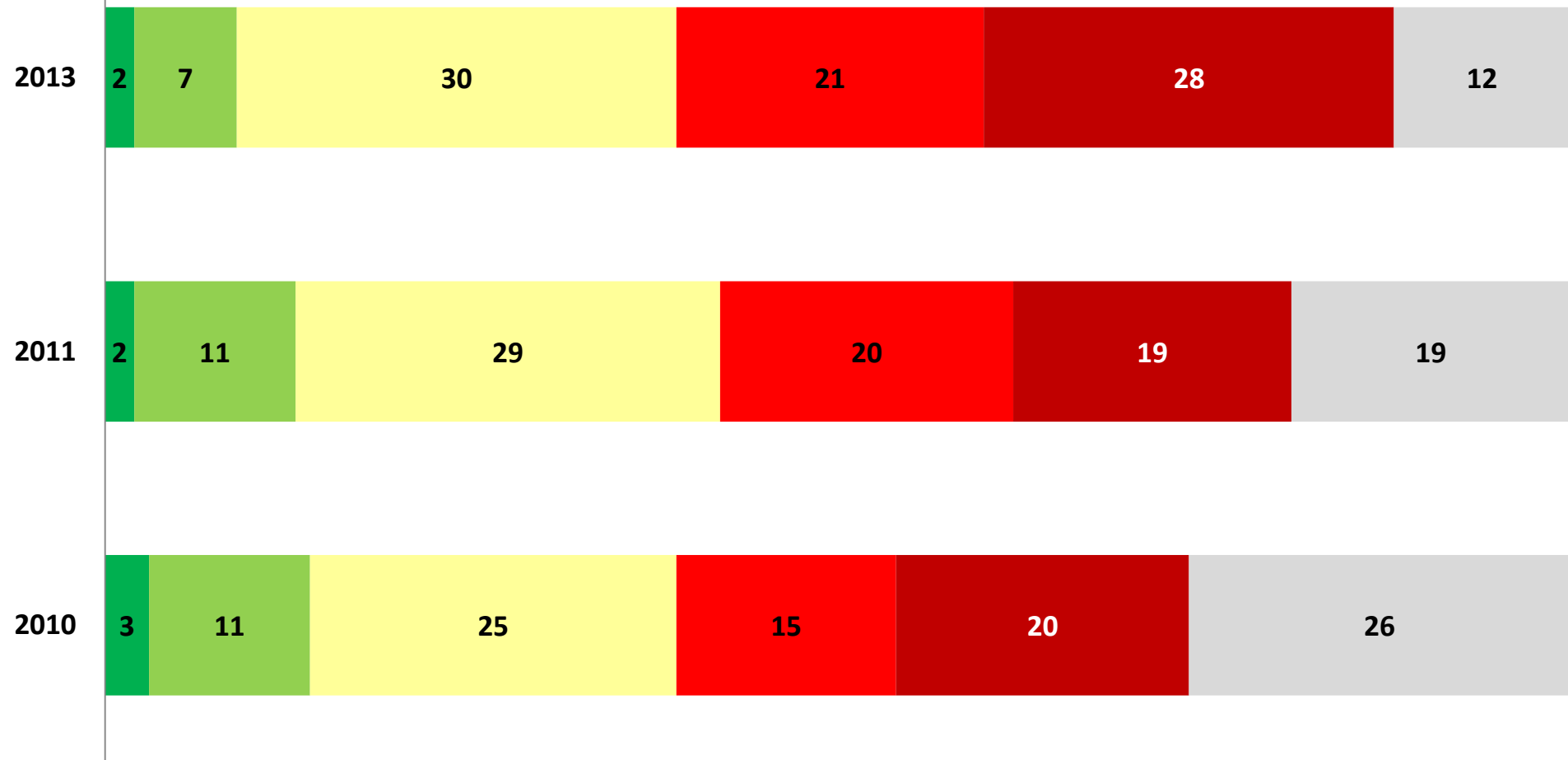

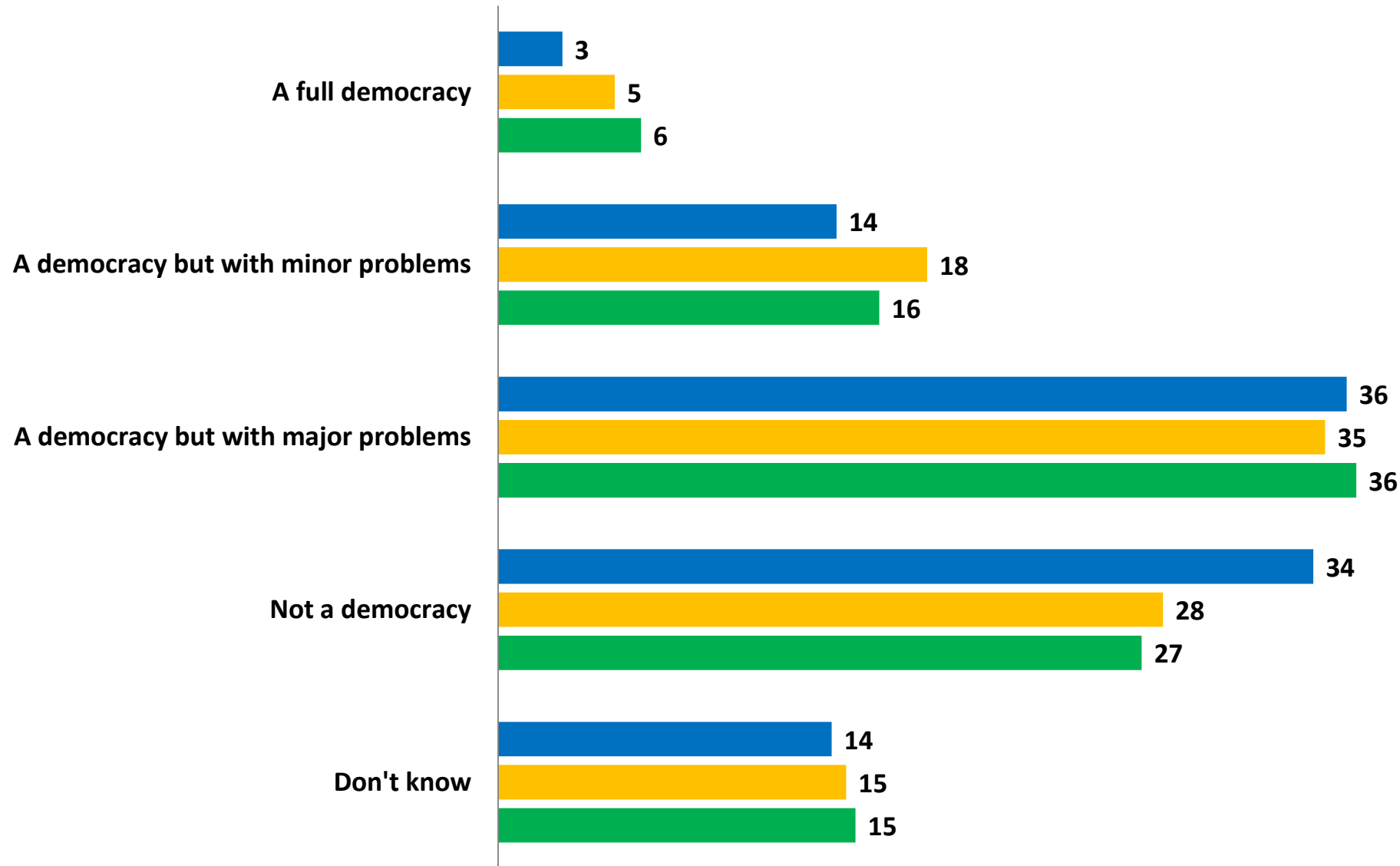

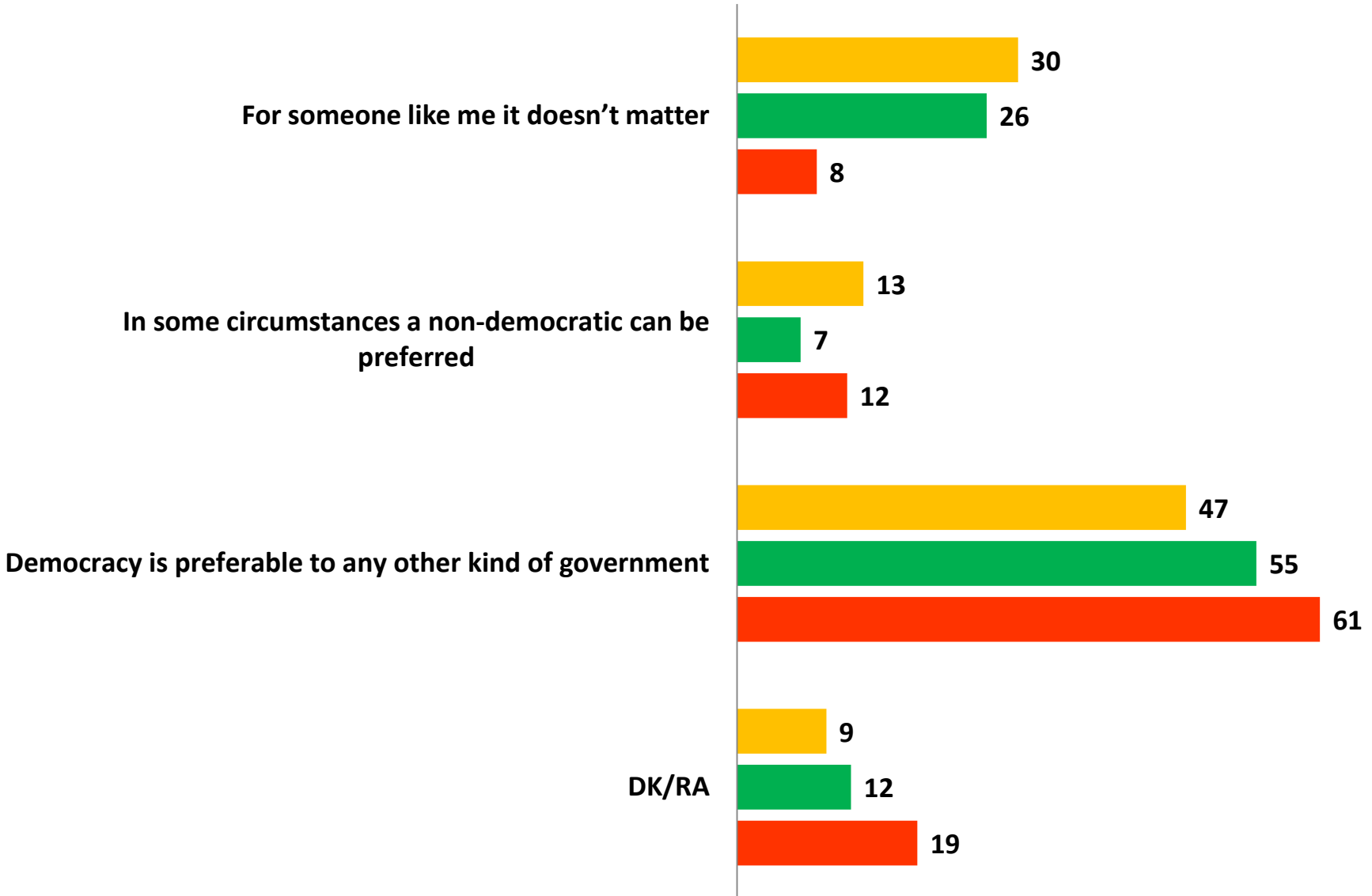

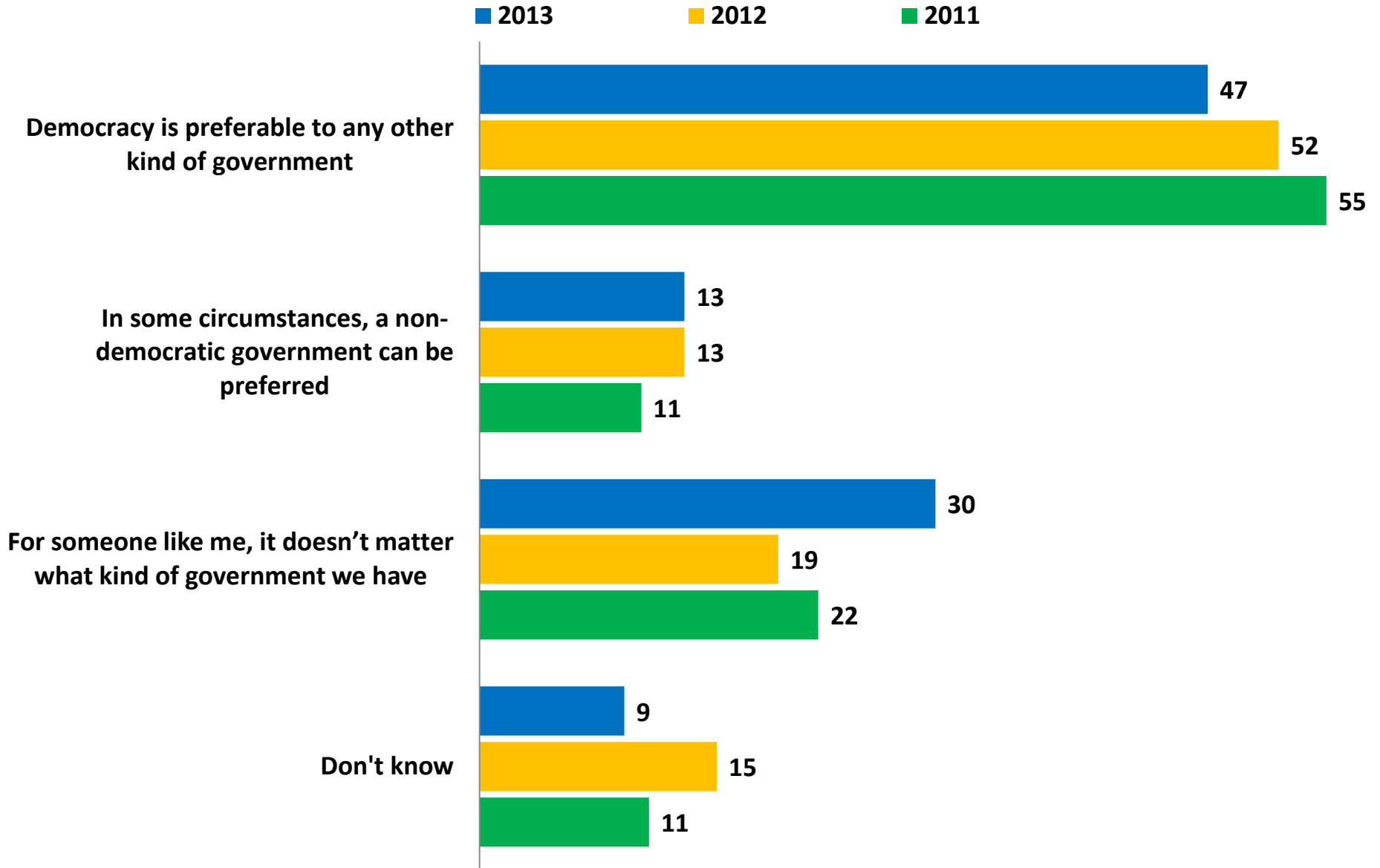

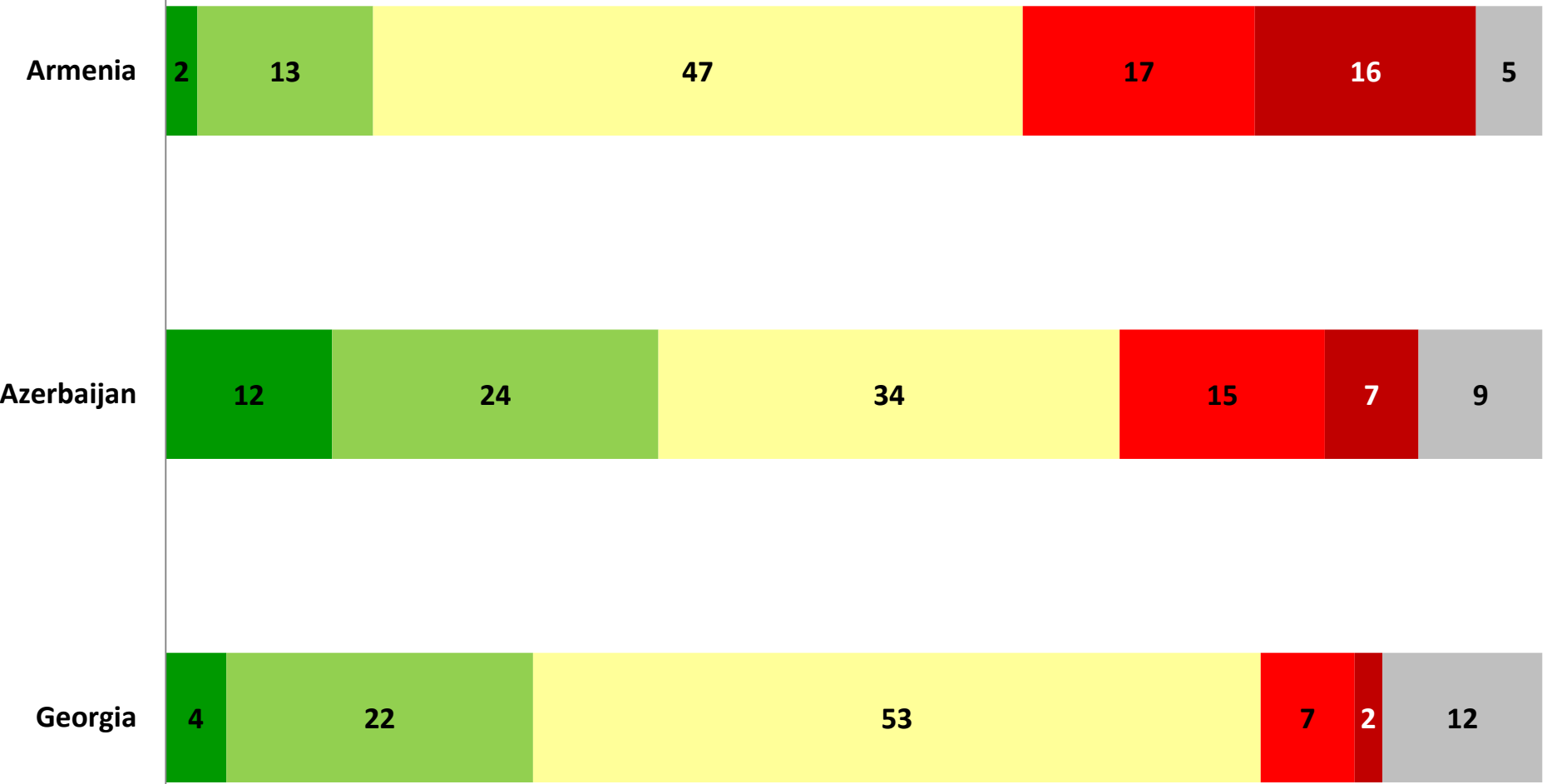

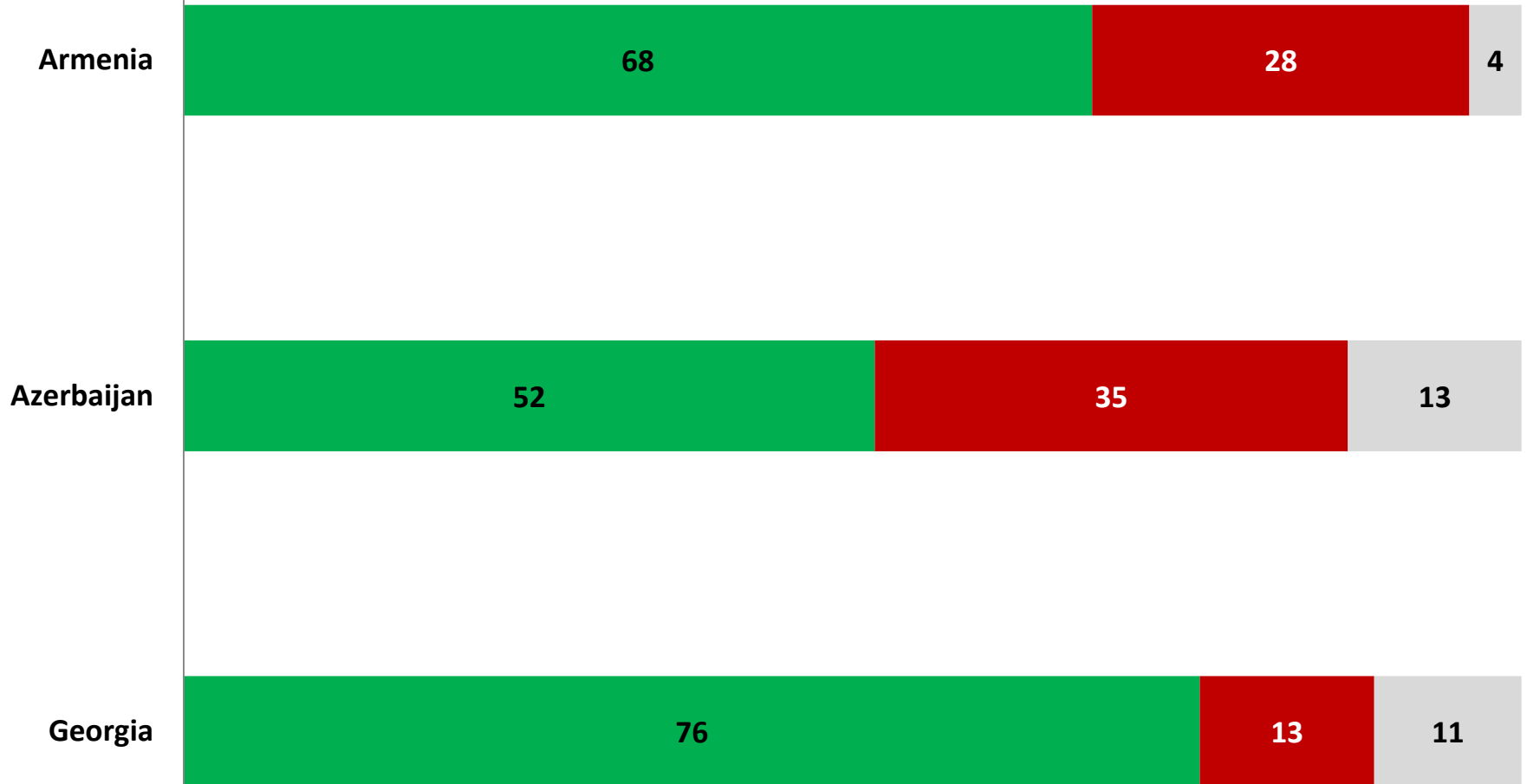
P2. How well TV journalists in your country inform the population (%)

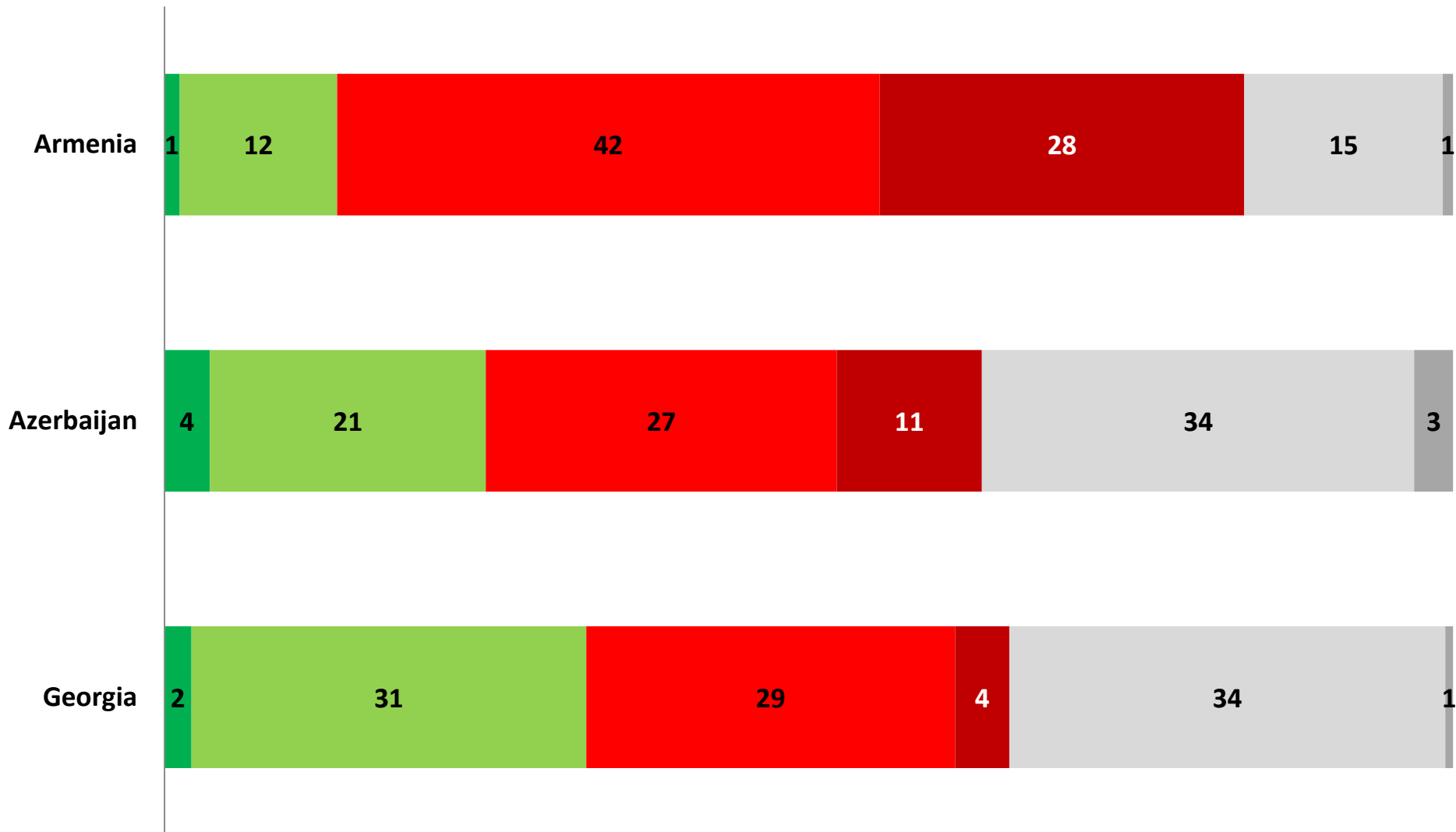
P8. People have the right to openly say what they think (%)

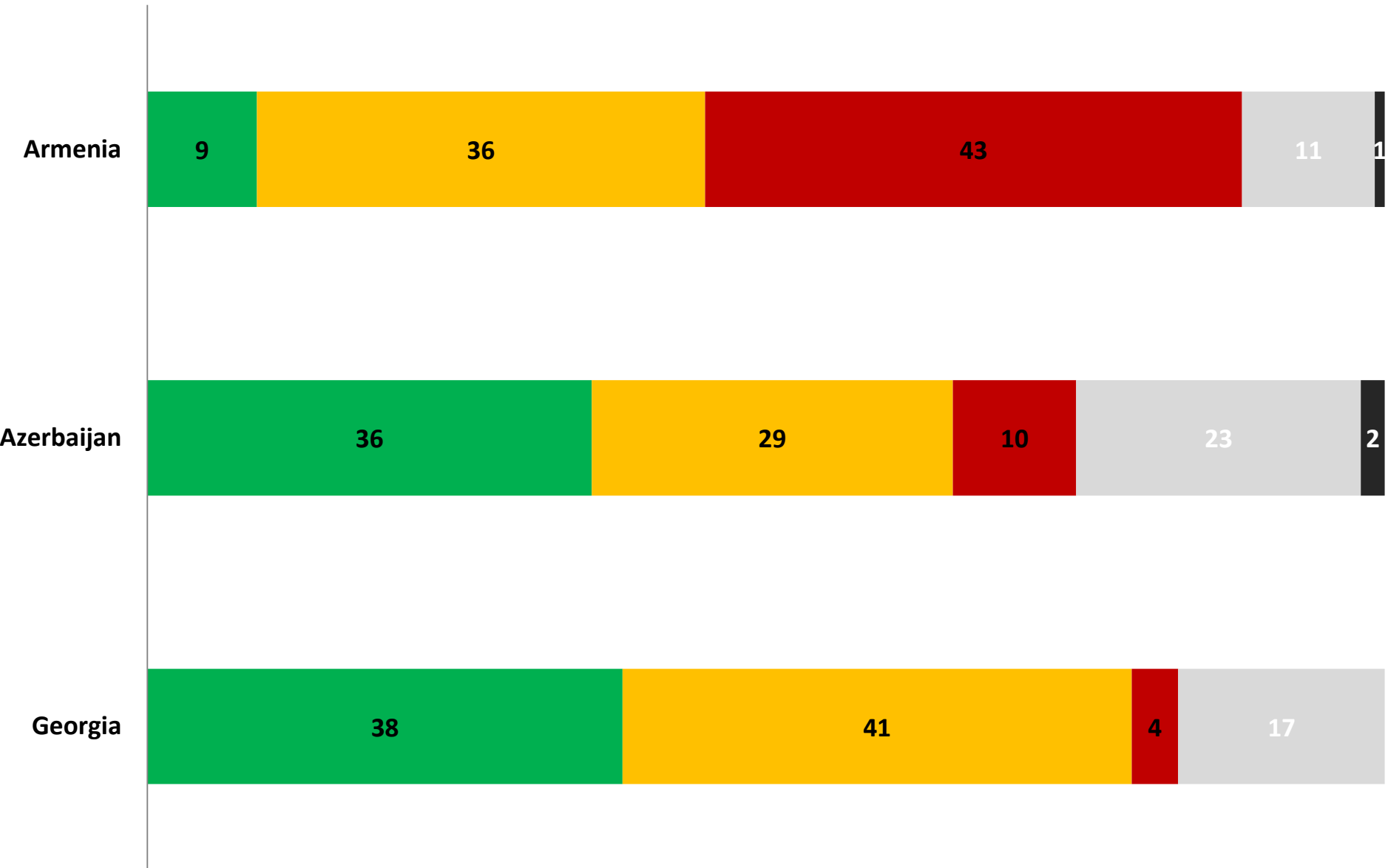

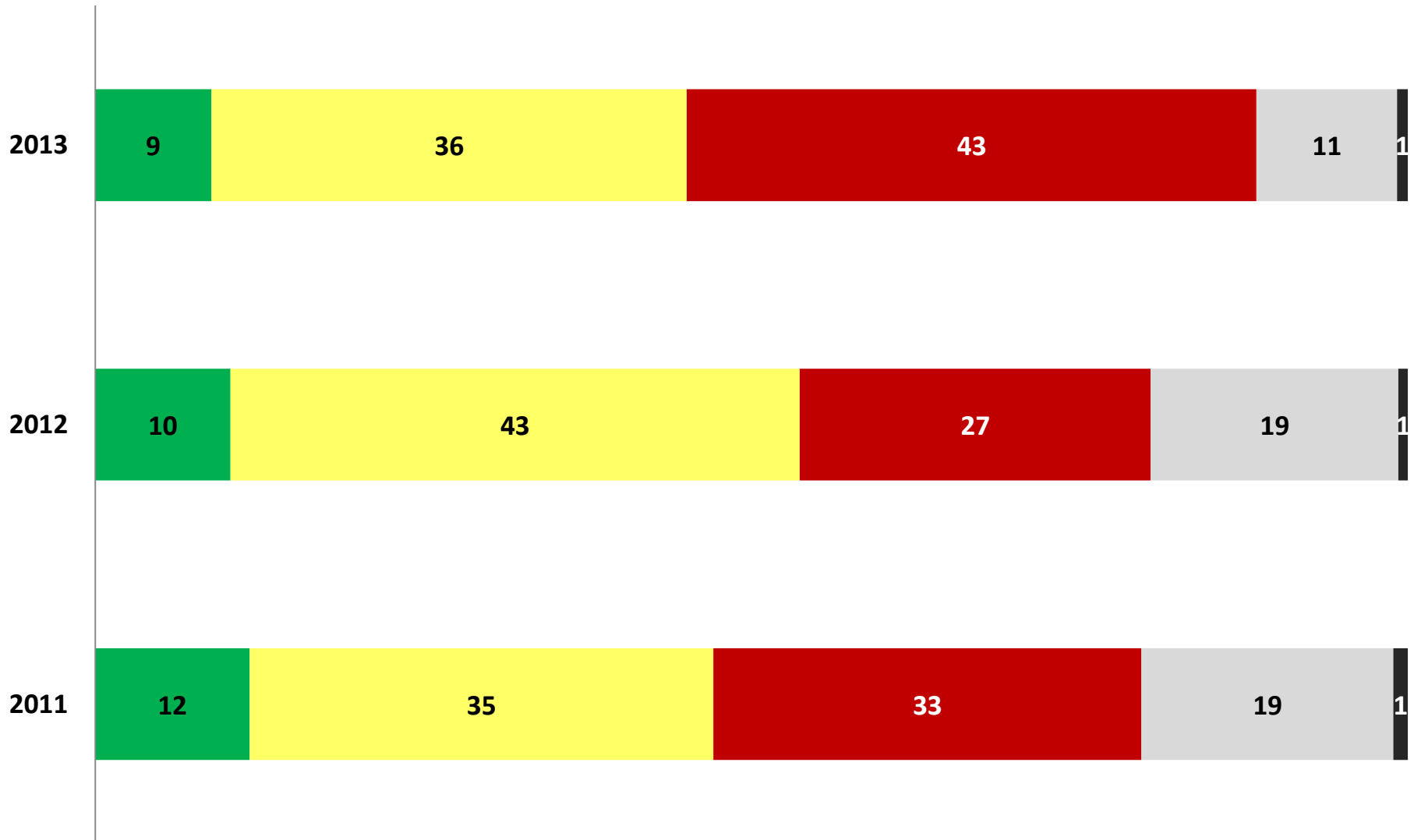

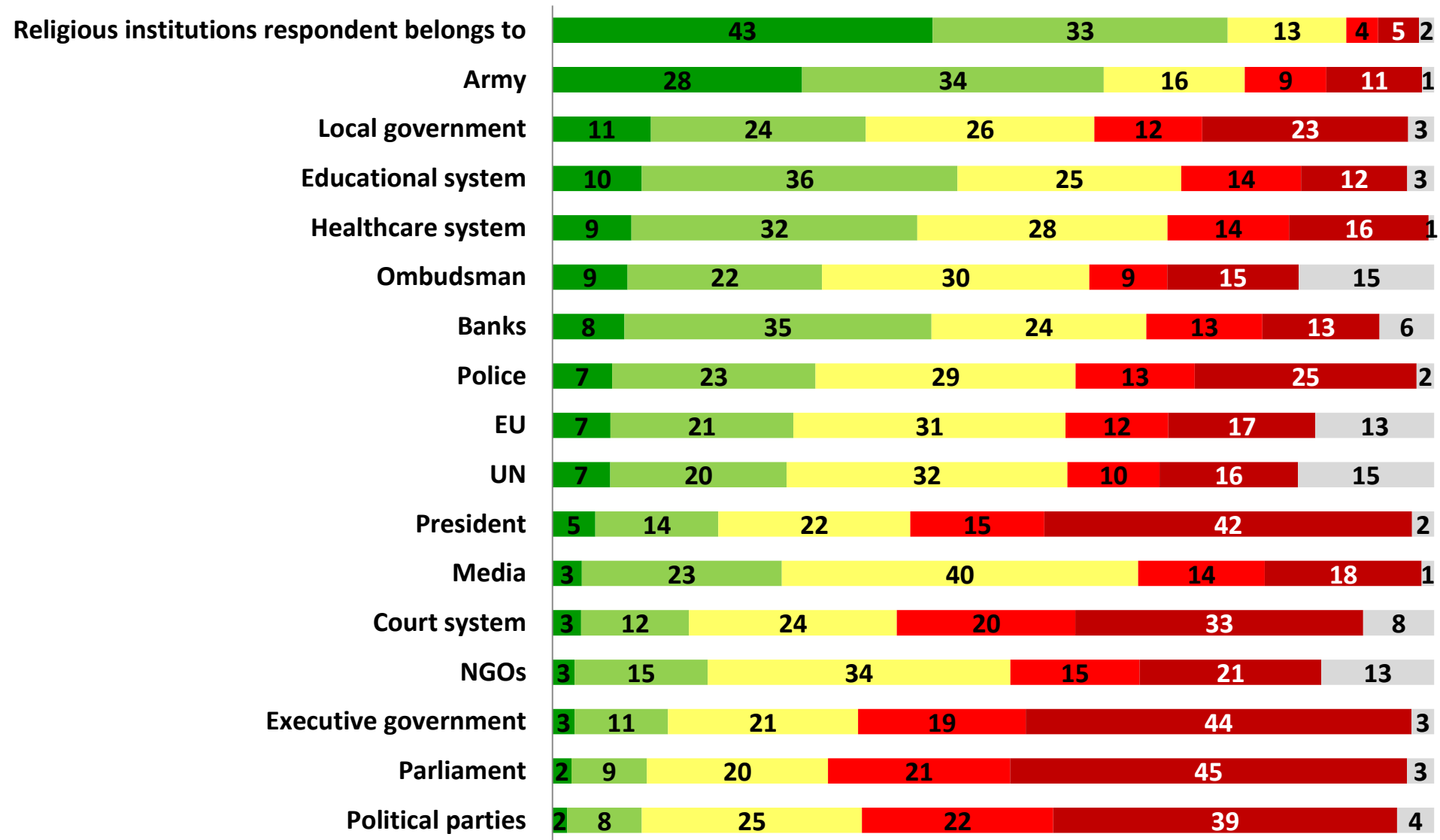

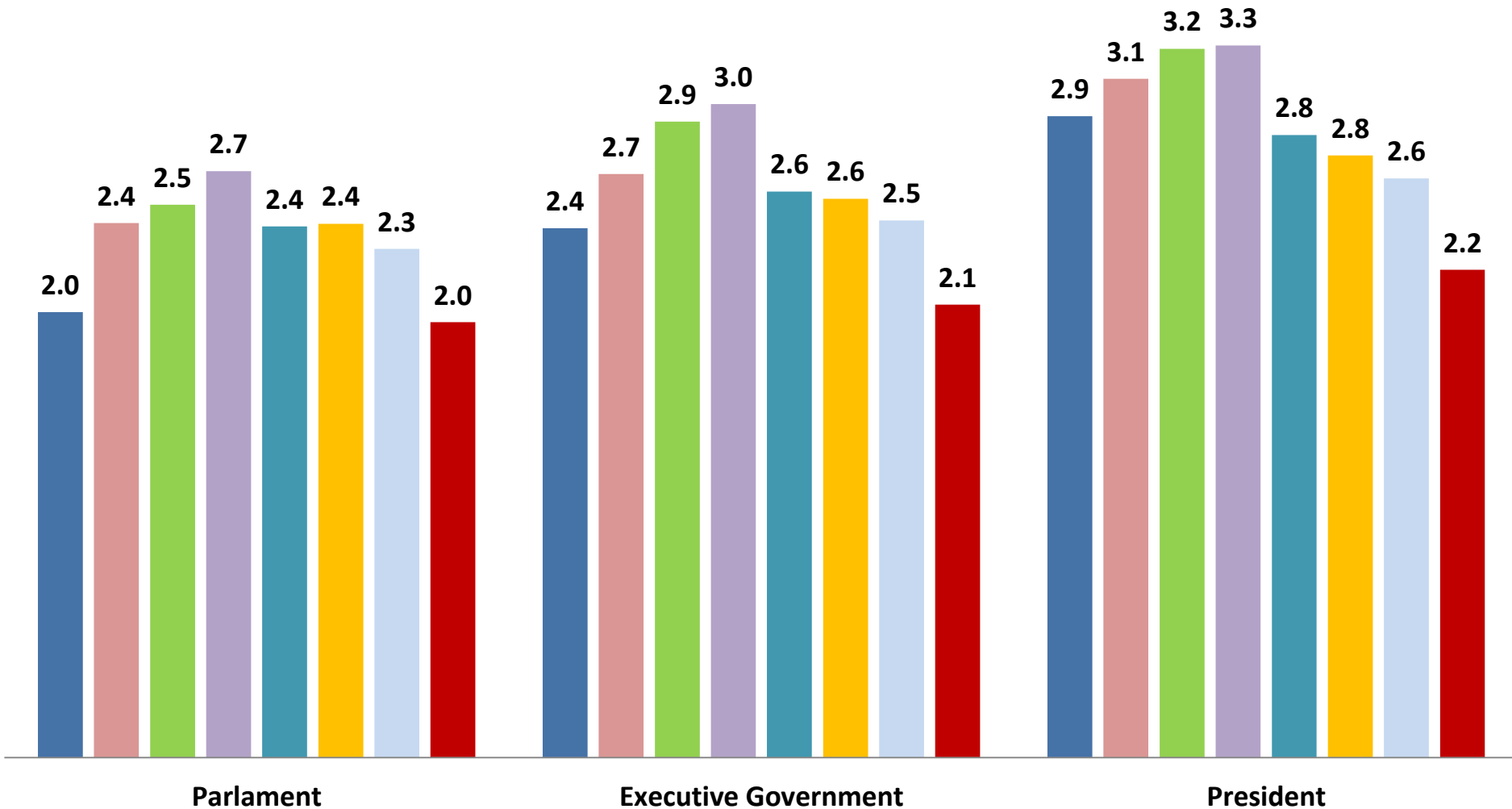

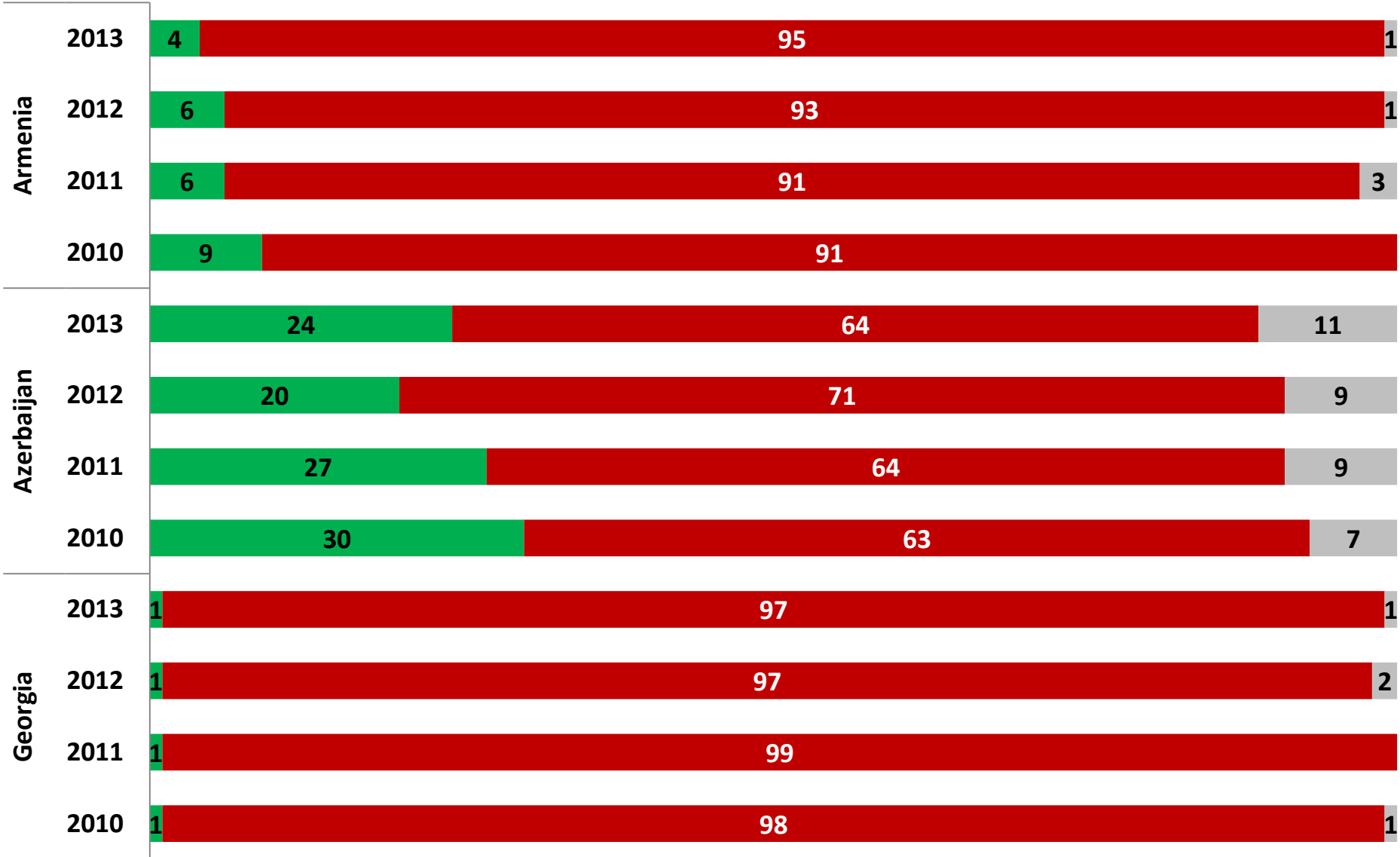

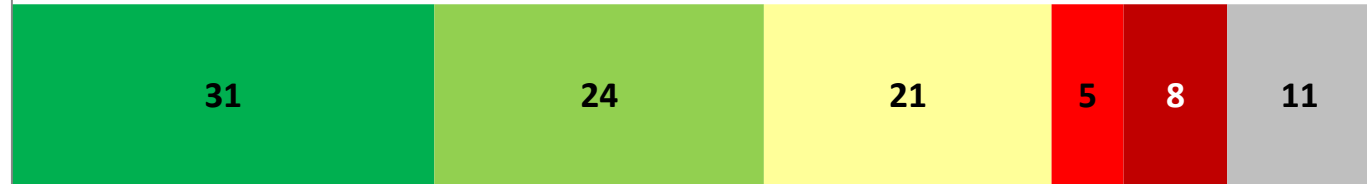

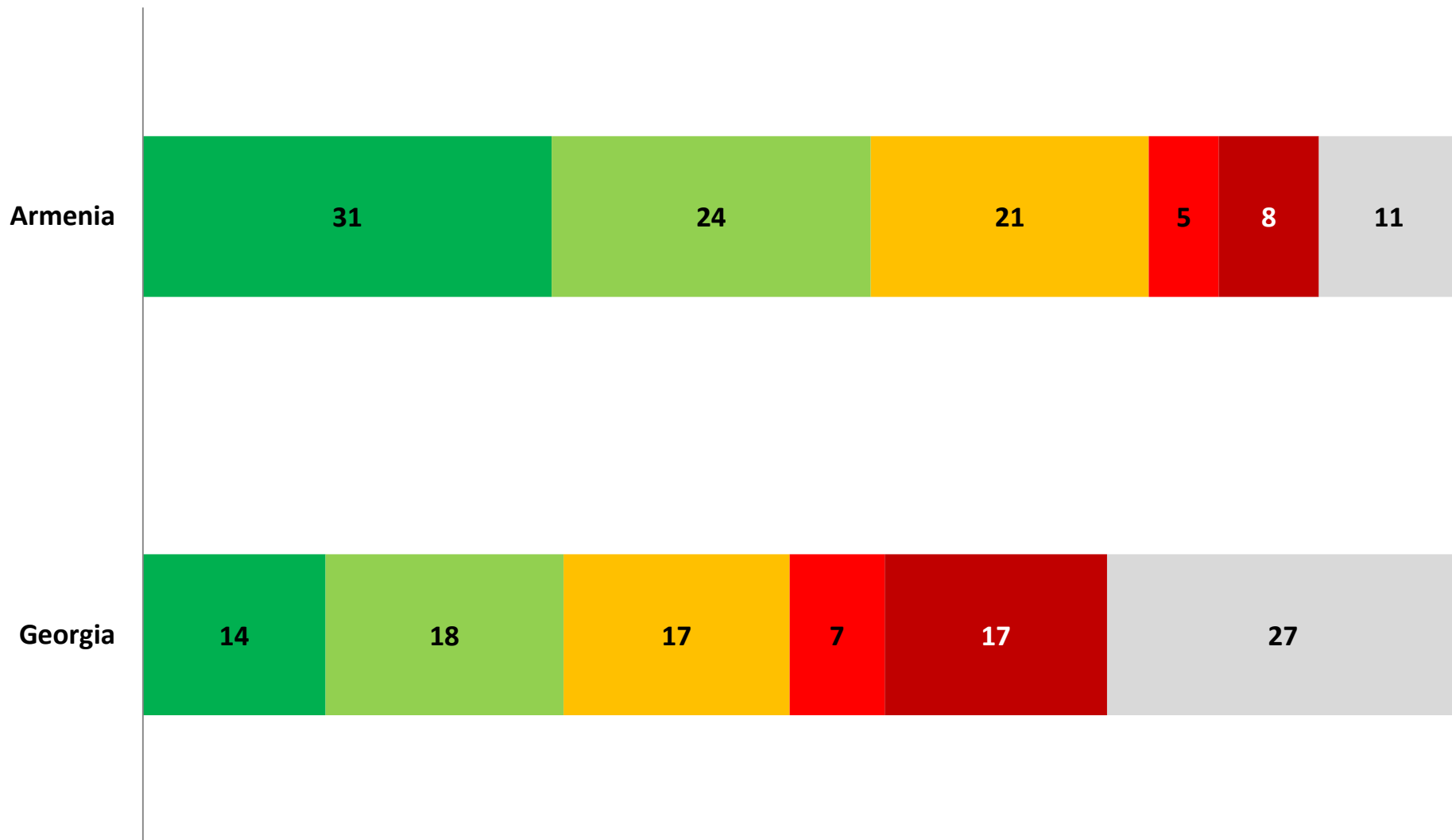

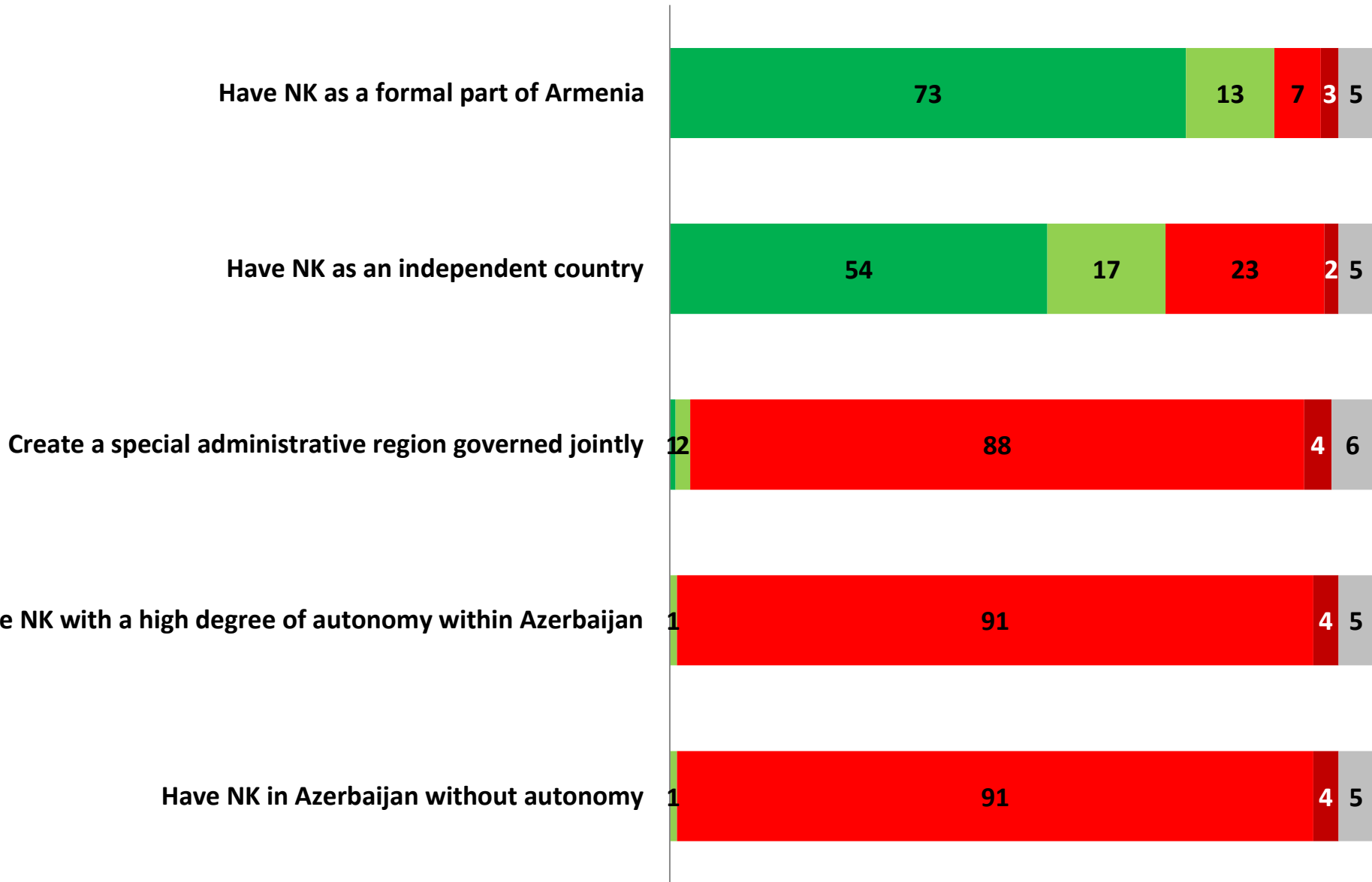

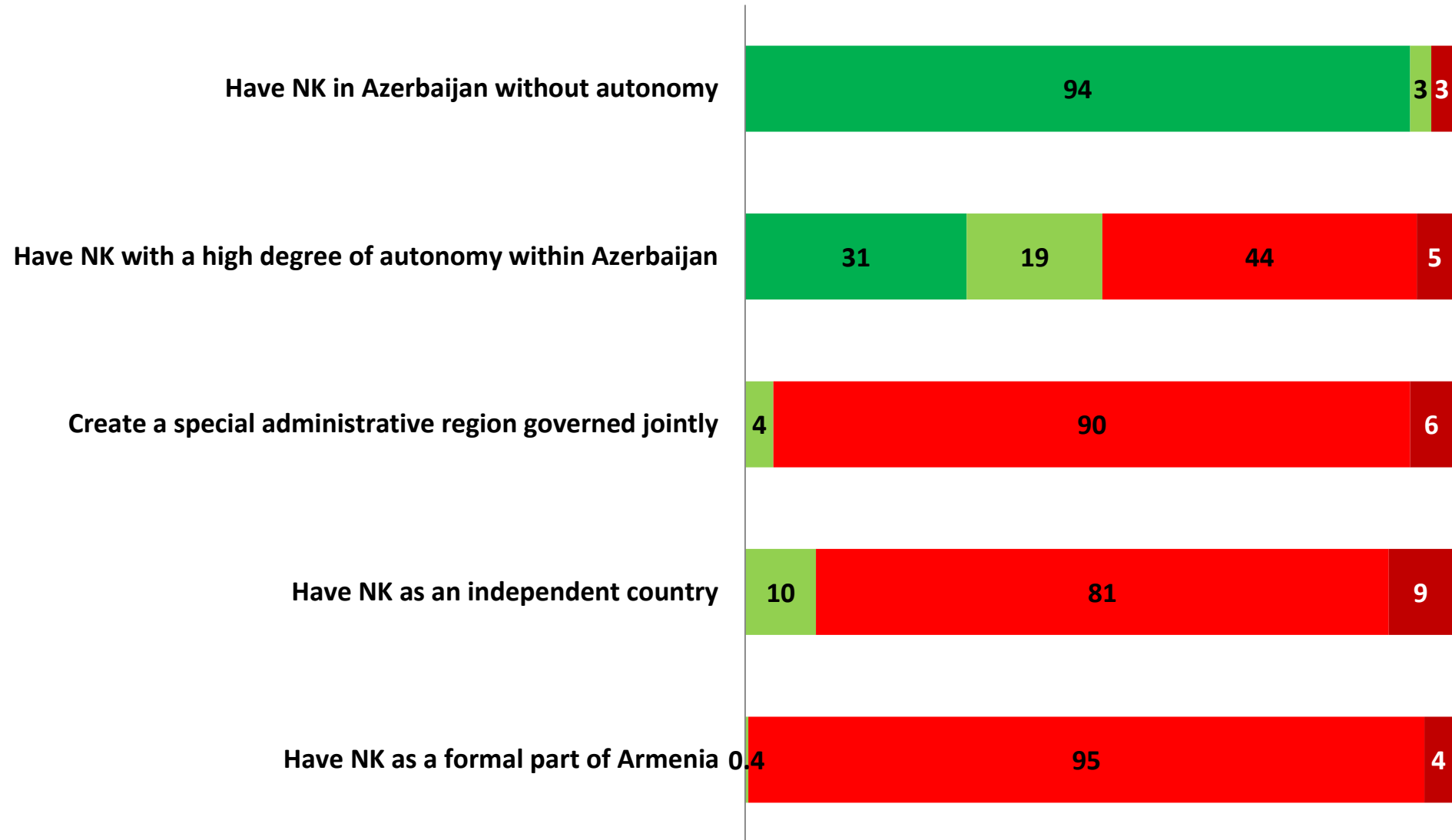

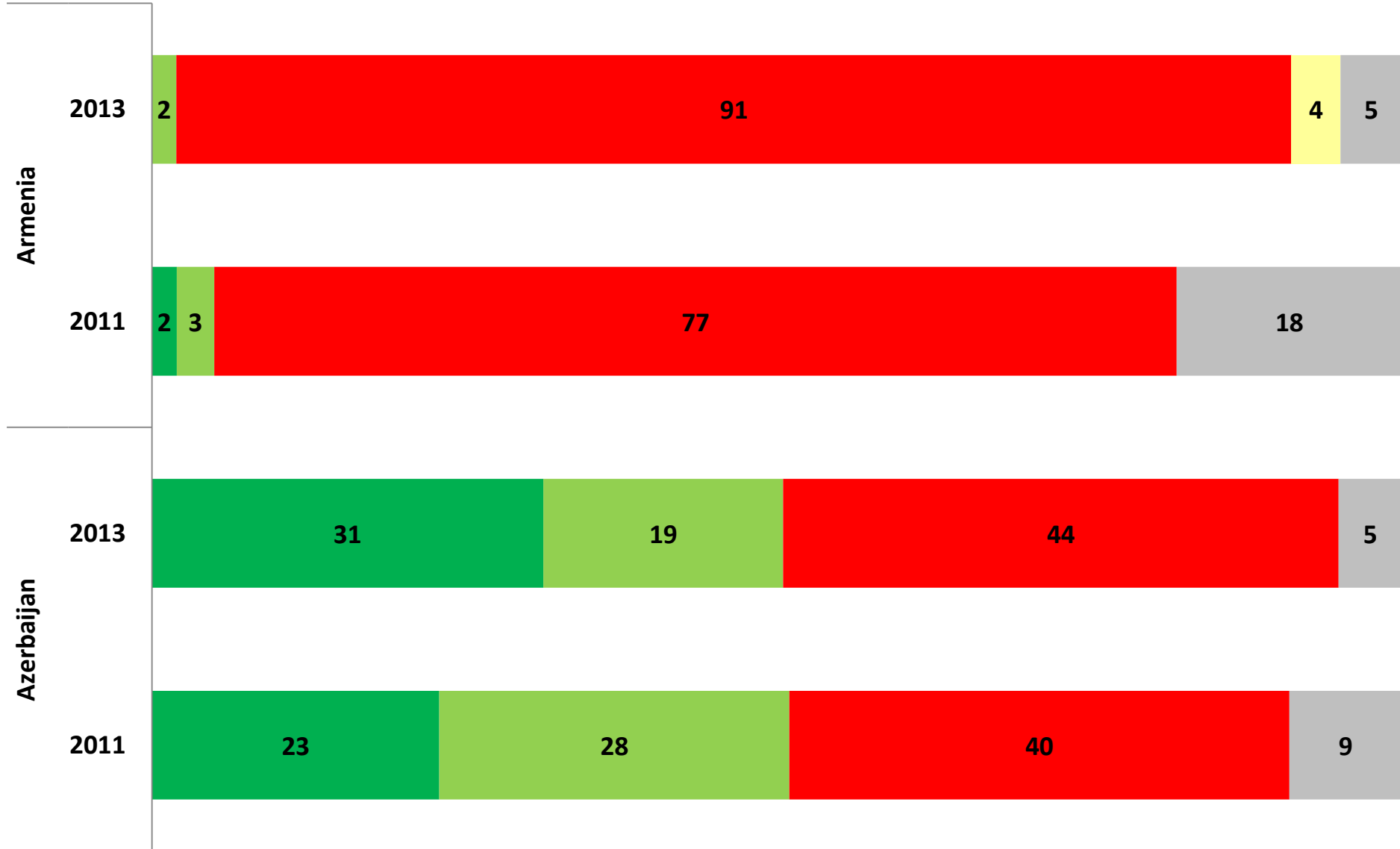

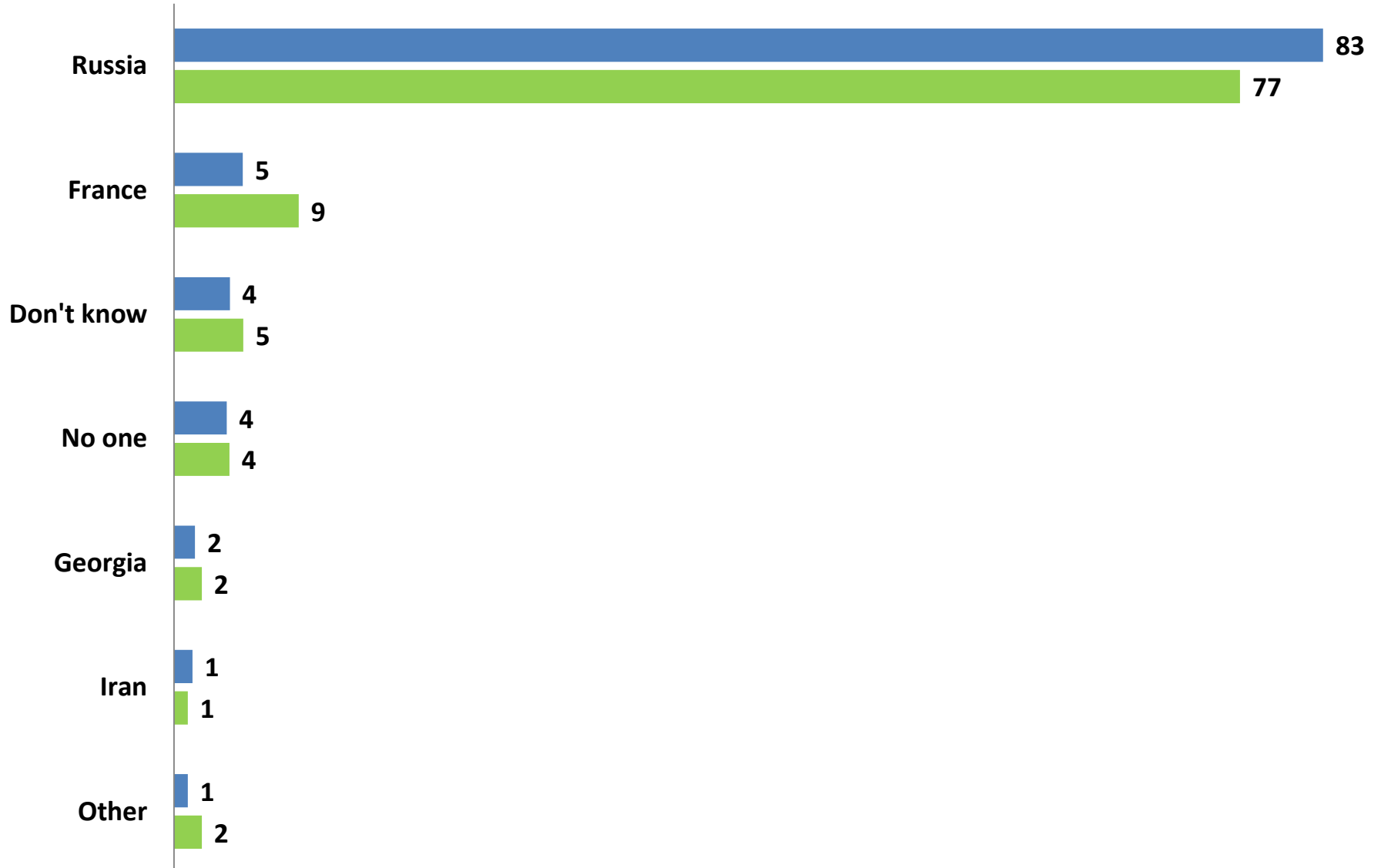

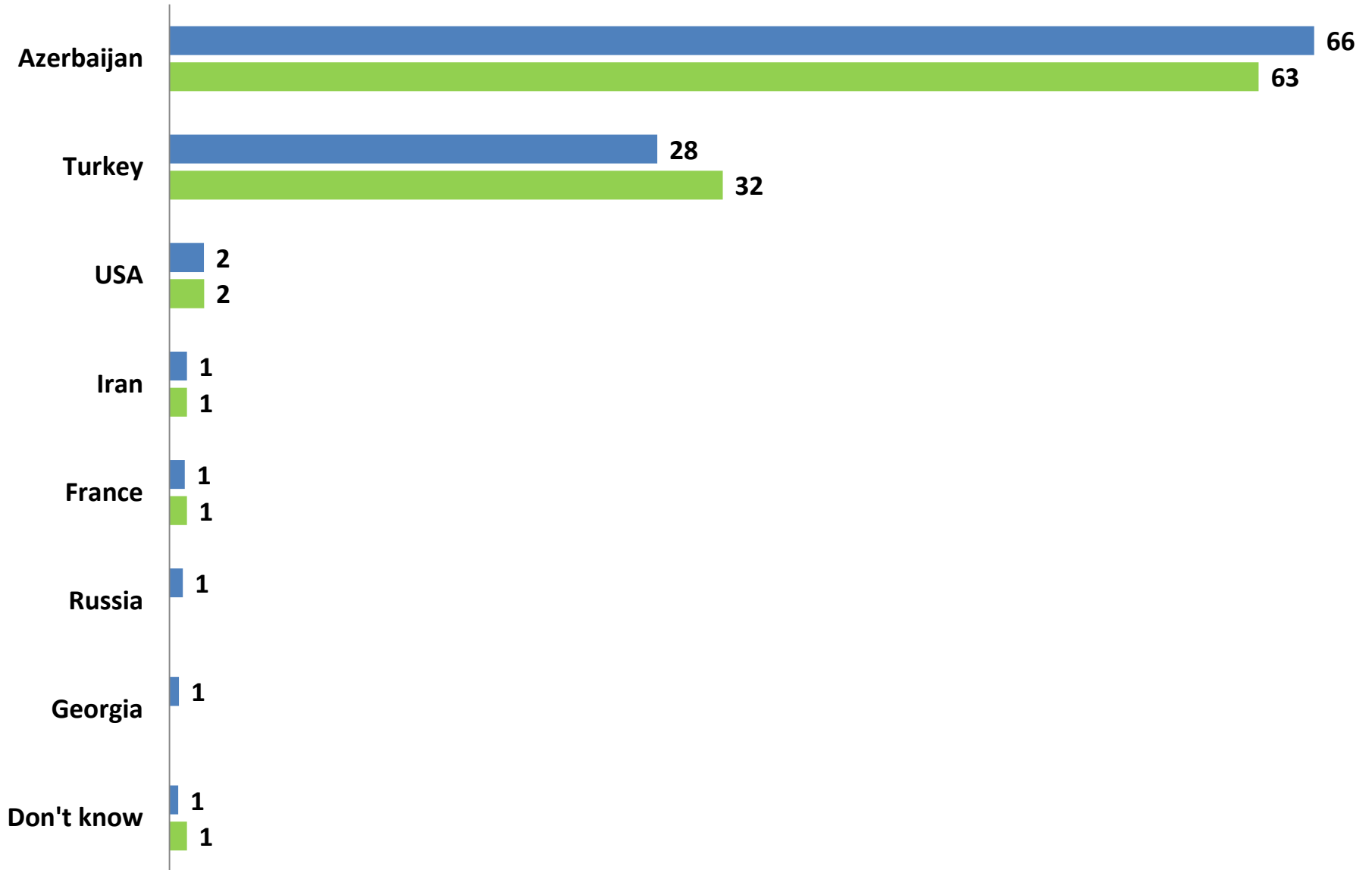

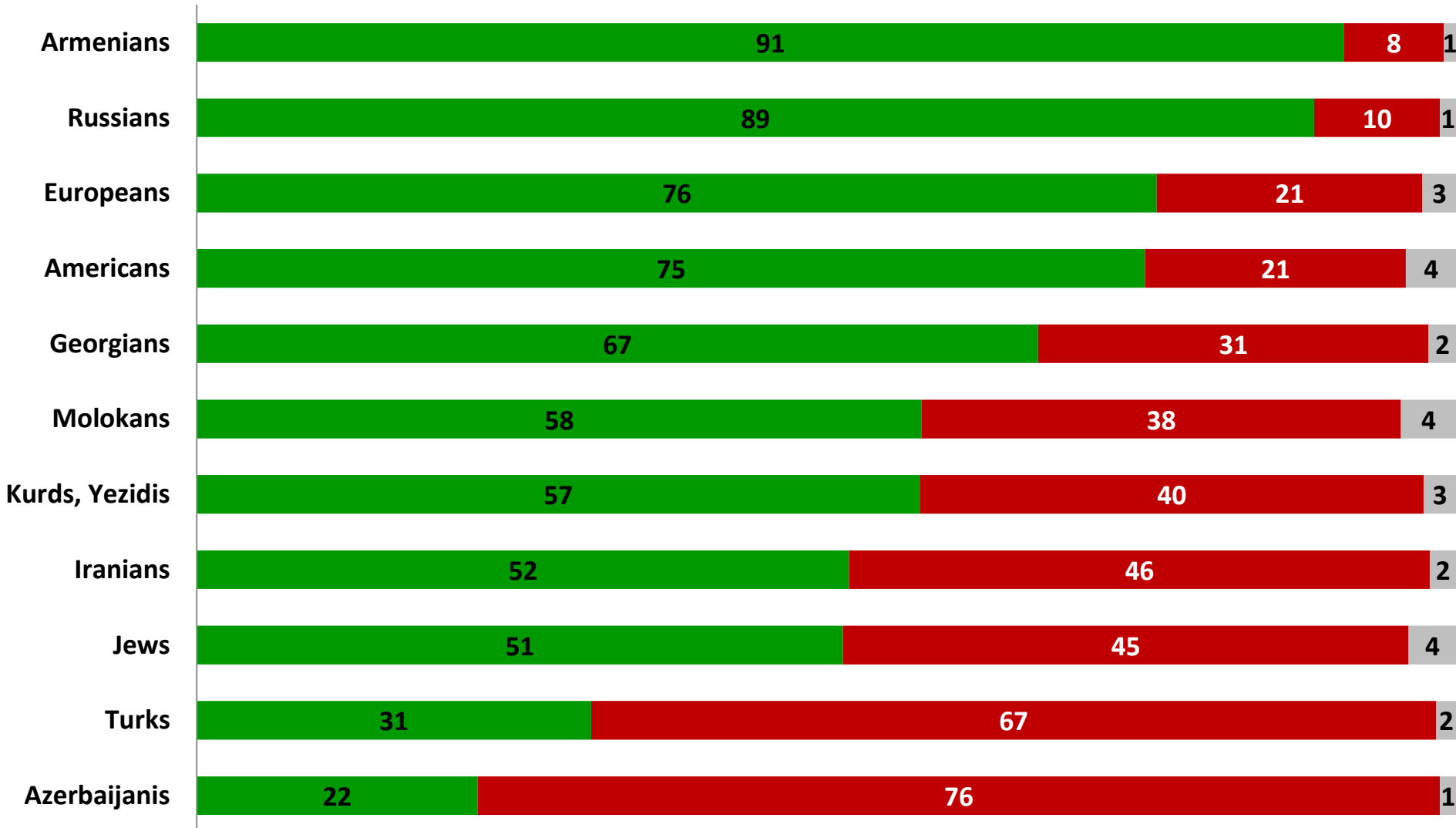

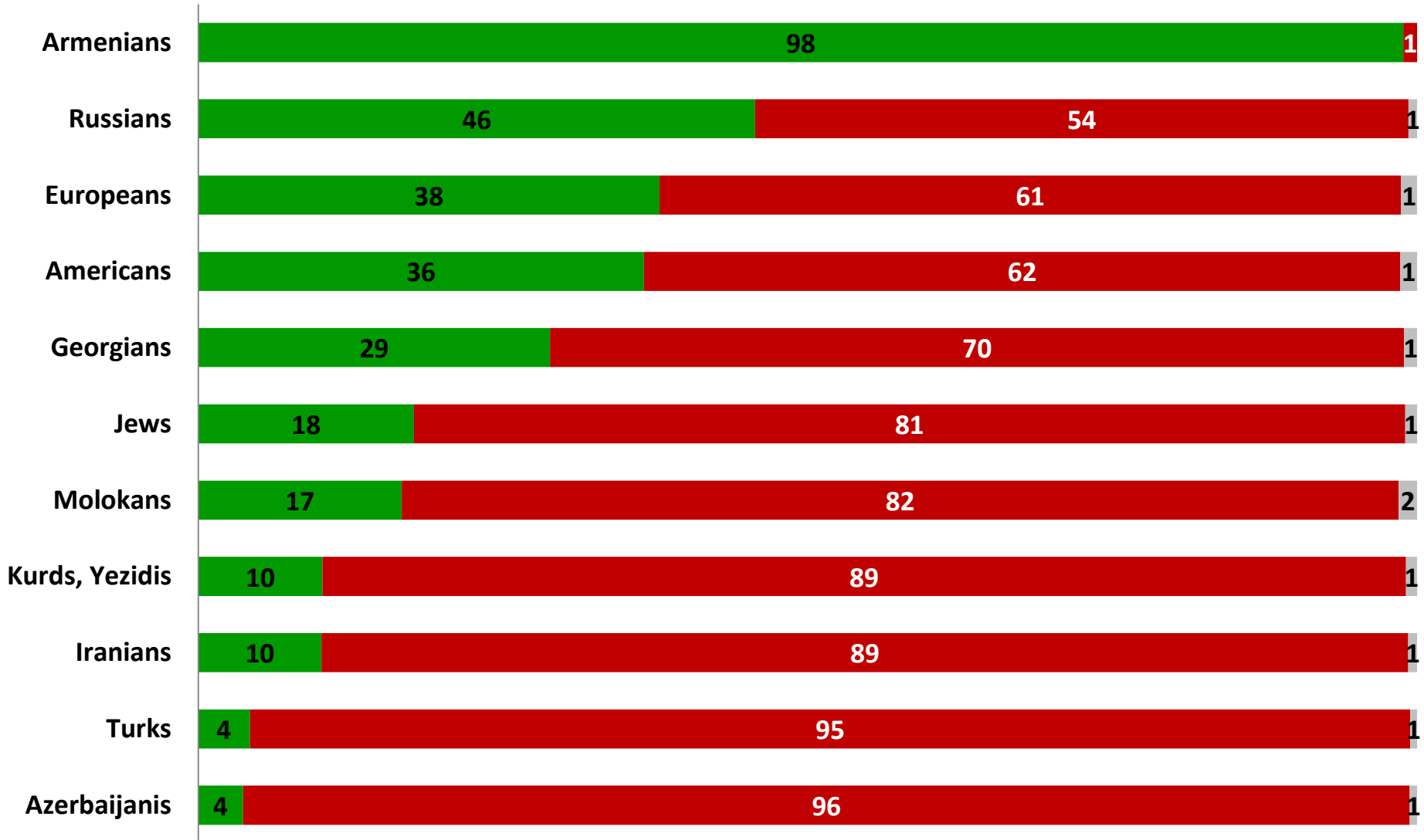

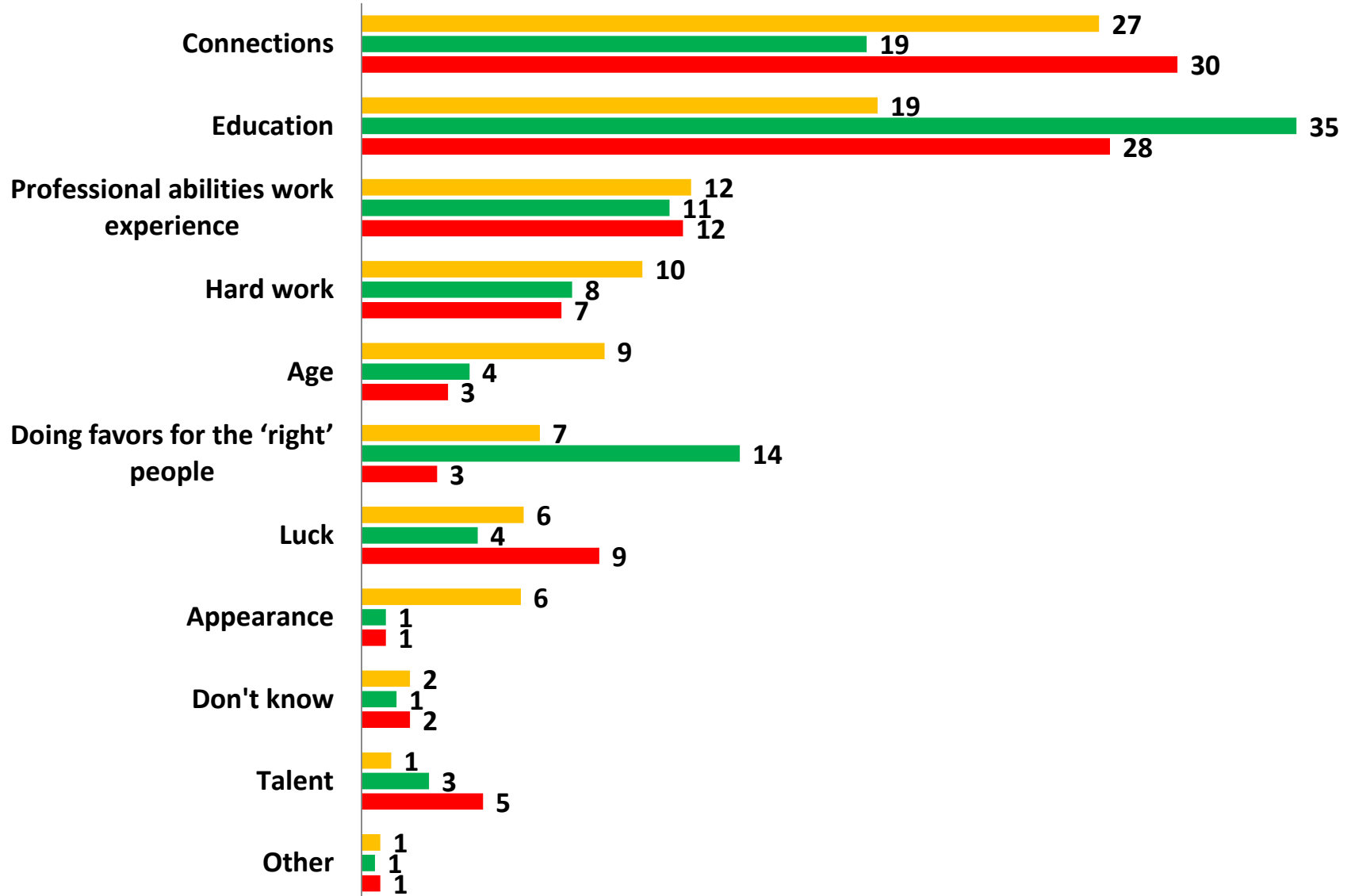

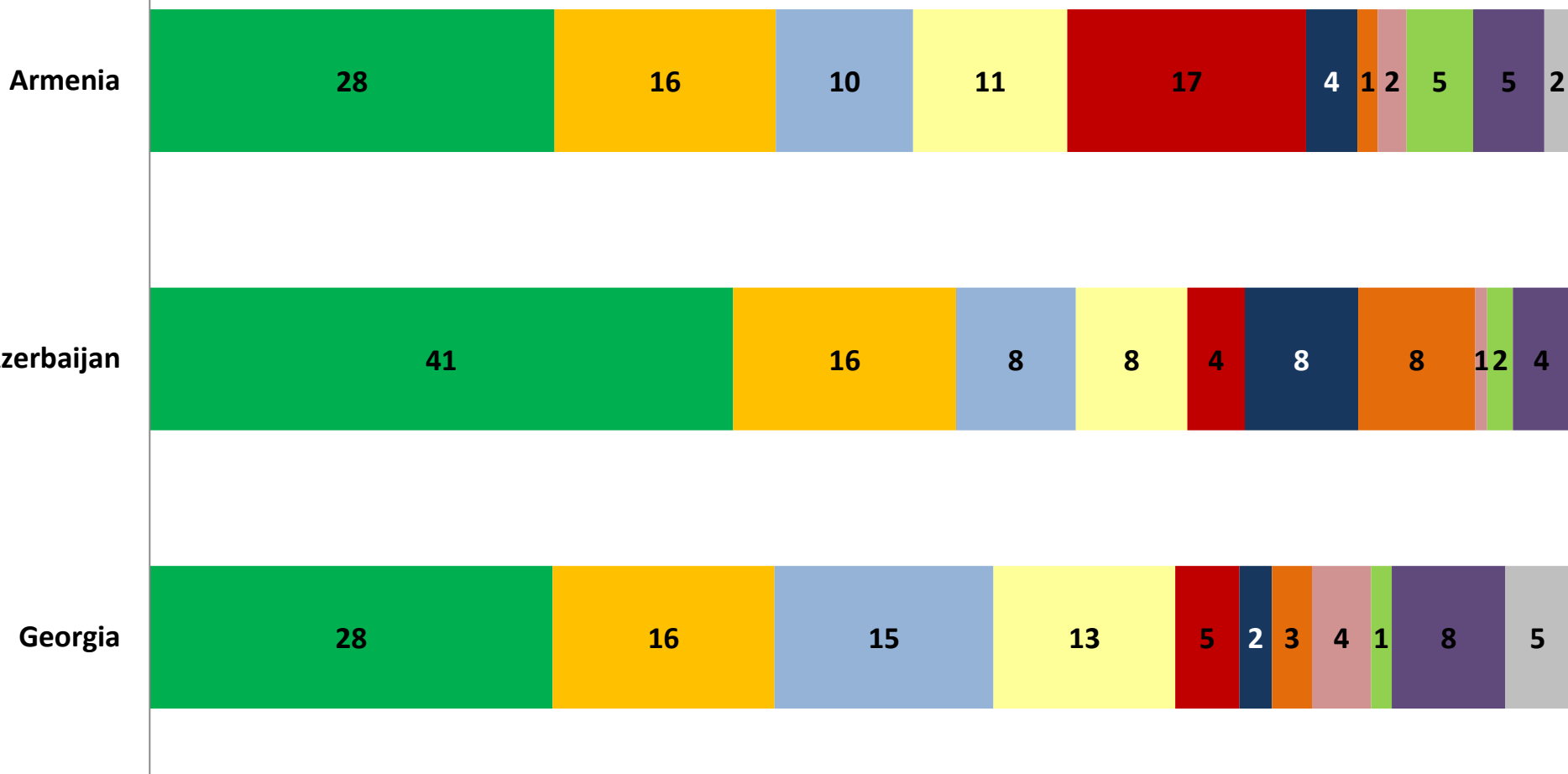

C15. Which of the following, in your opinion, will contribute to your children being better off? (of the respondents who think their children will be better off; %)

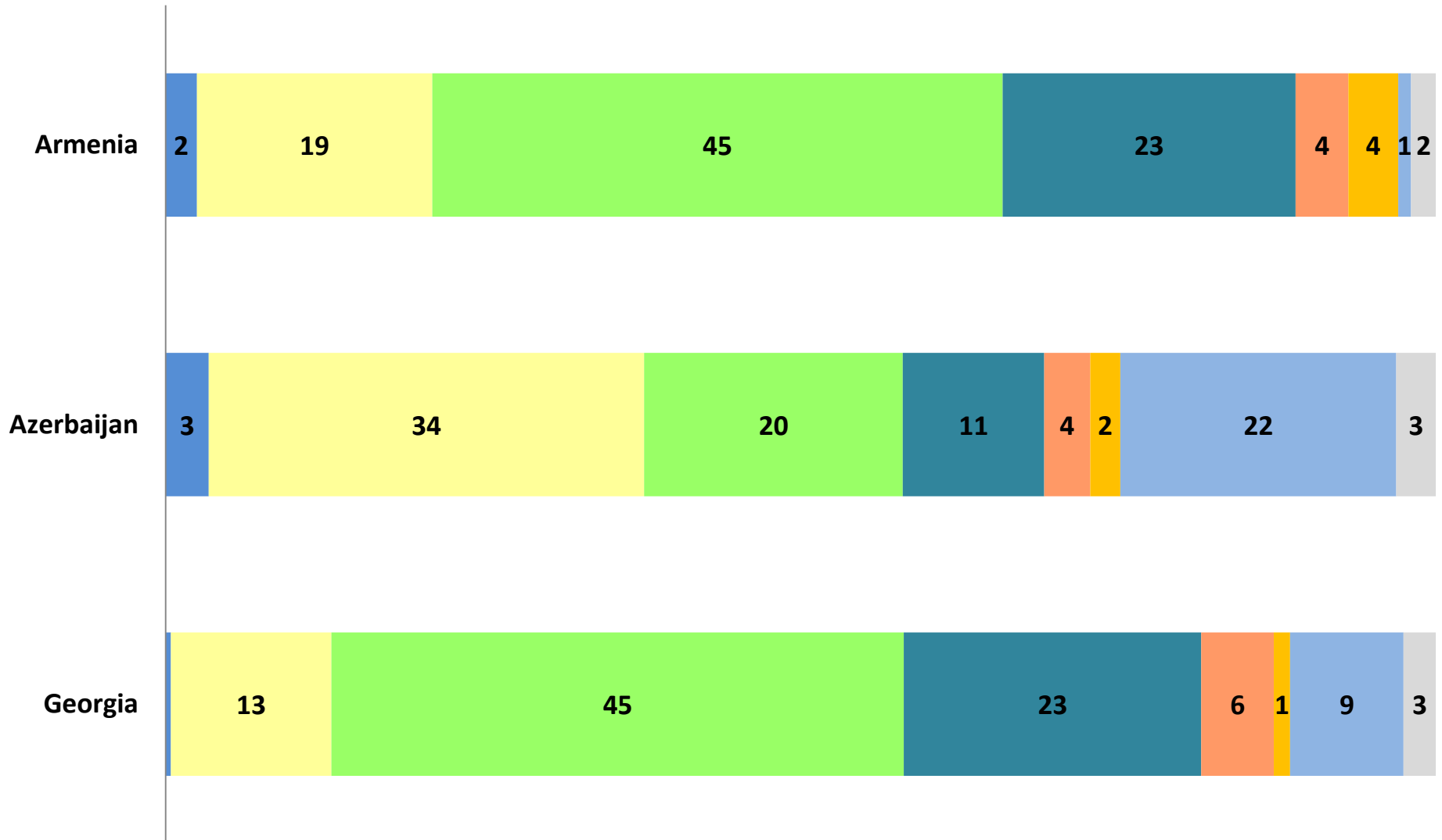

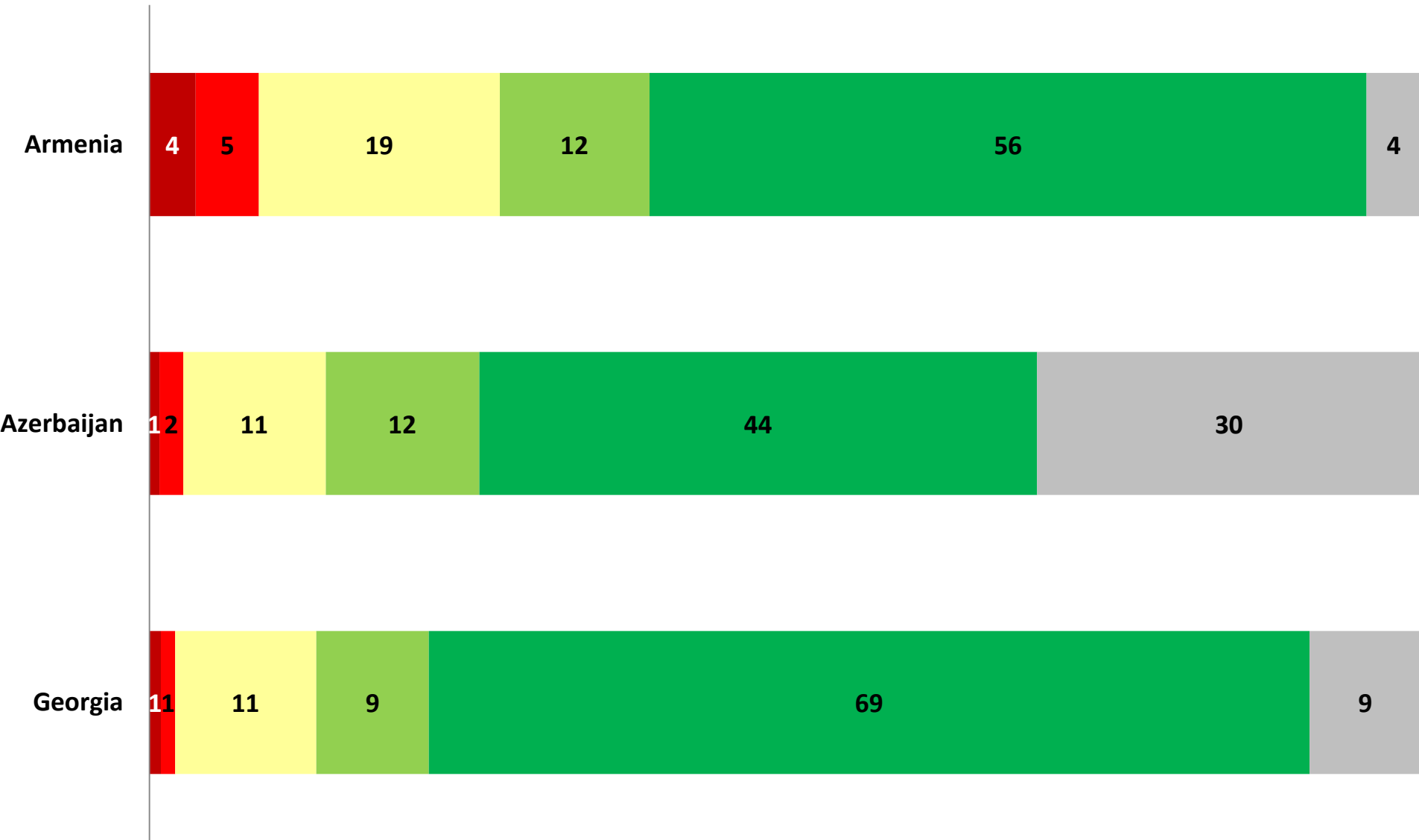

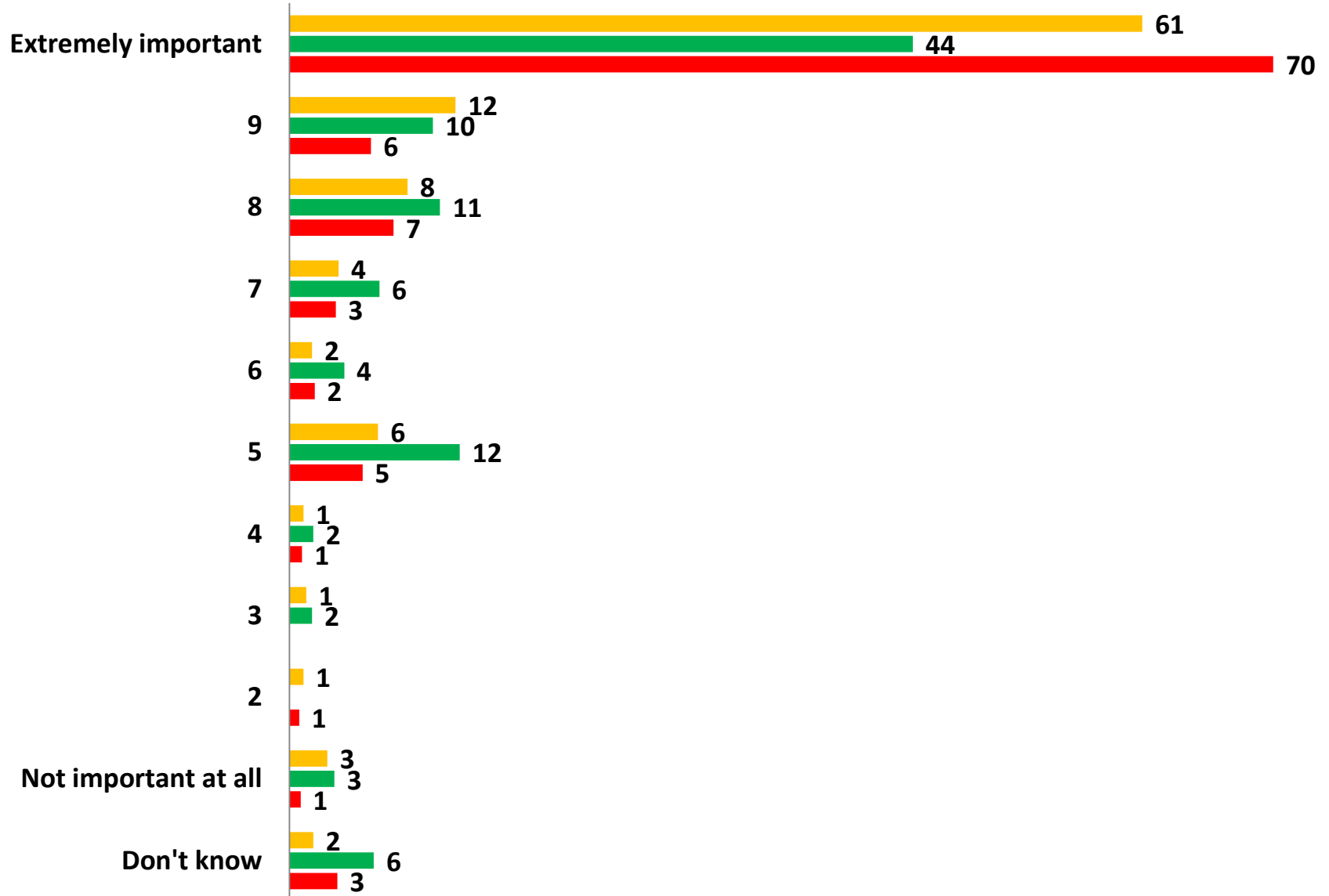

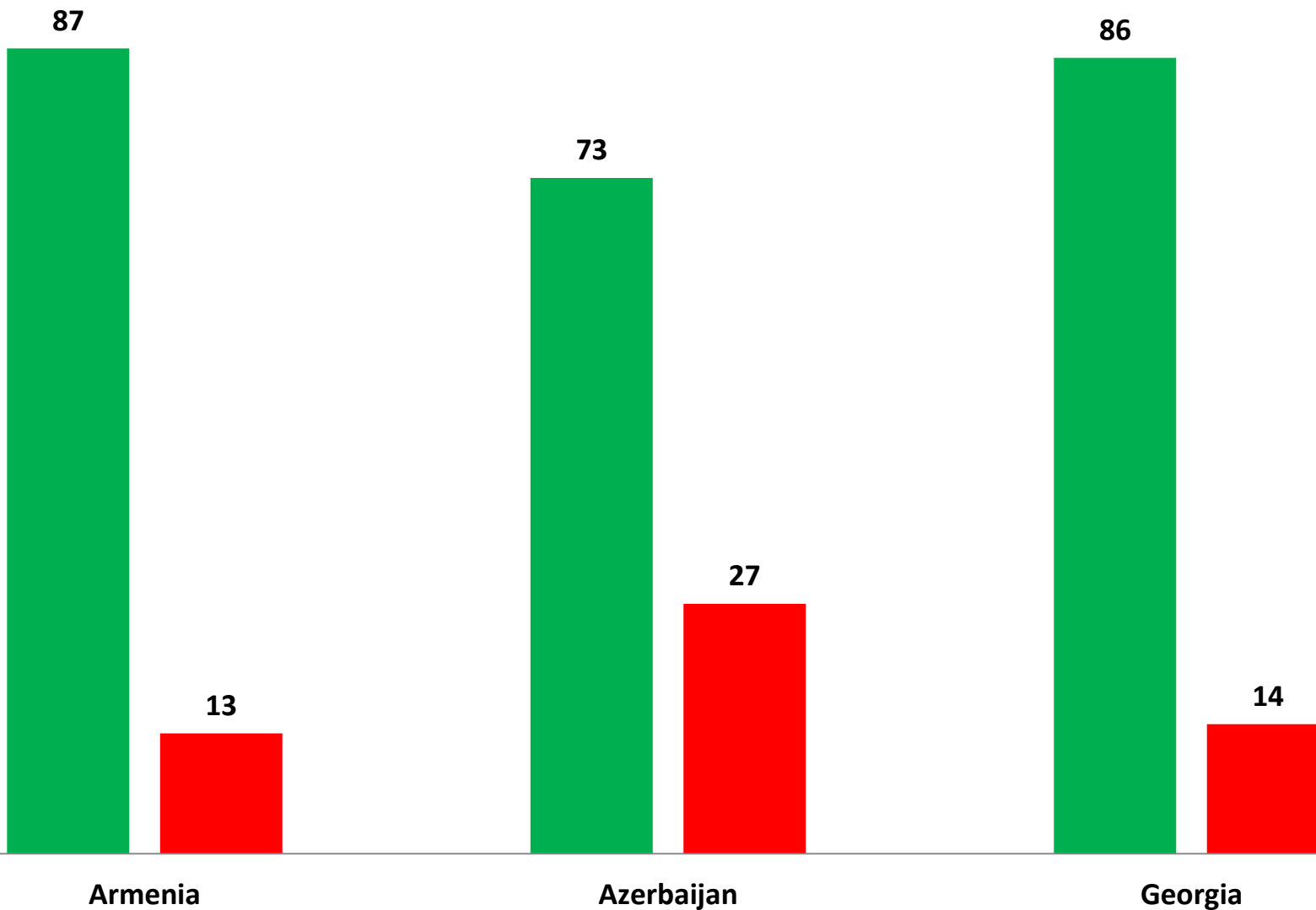

P14. Did you vote in the last national elections? (%)

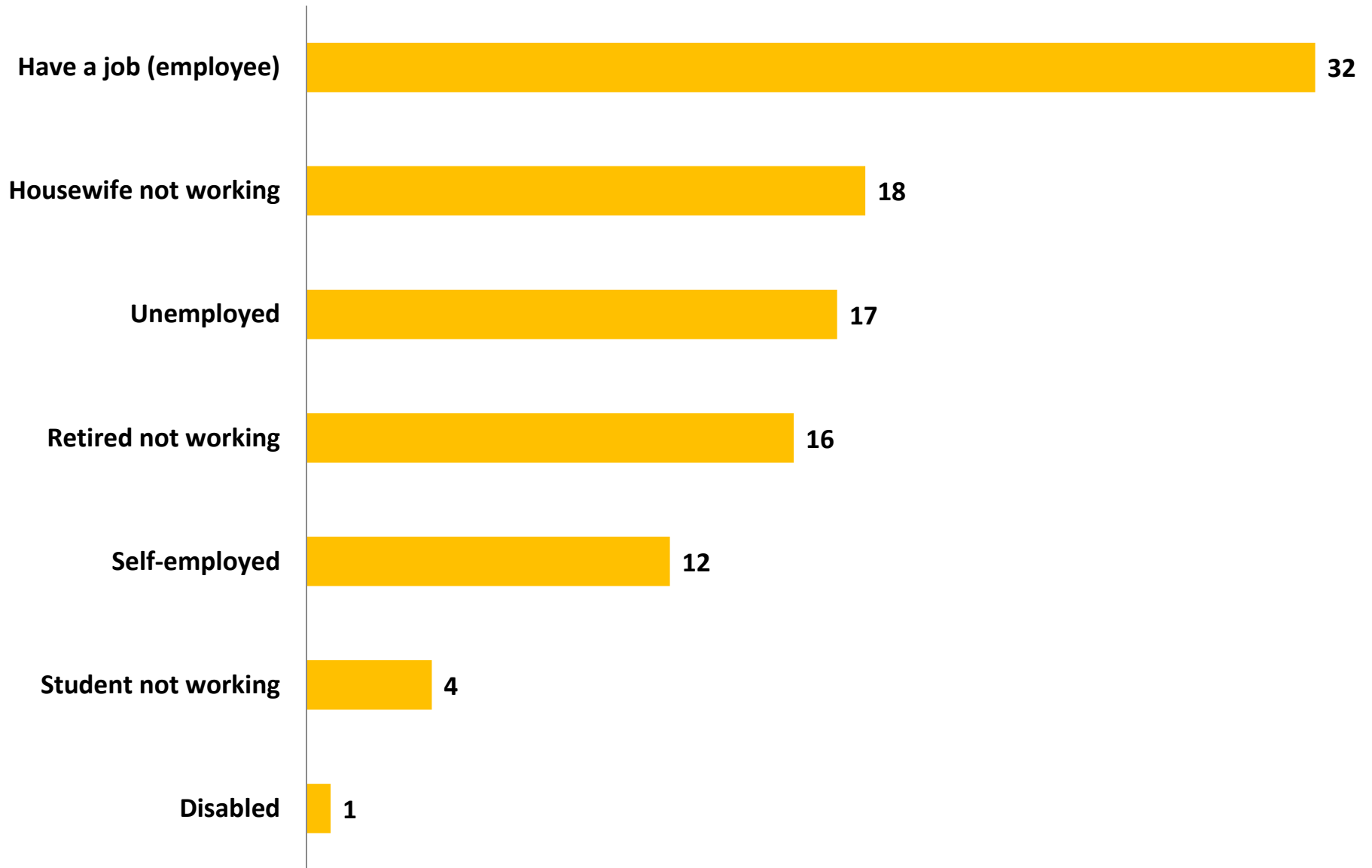

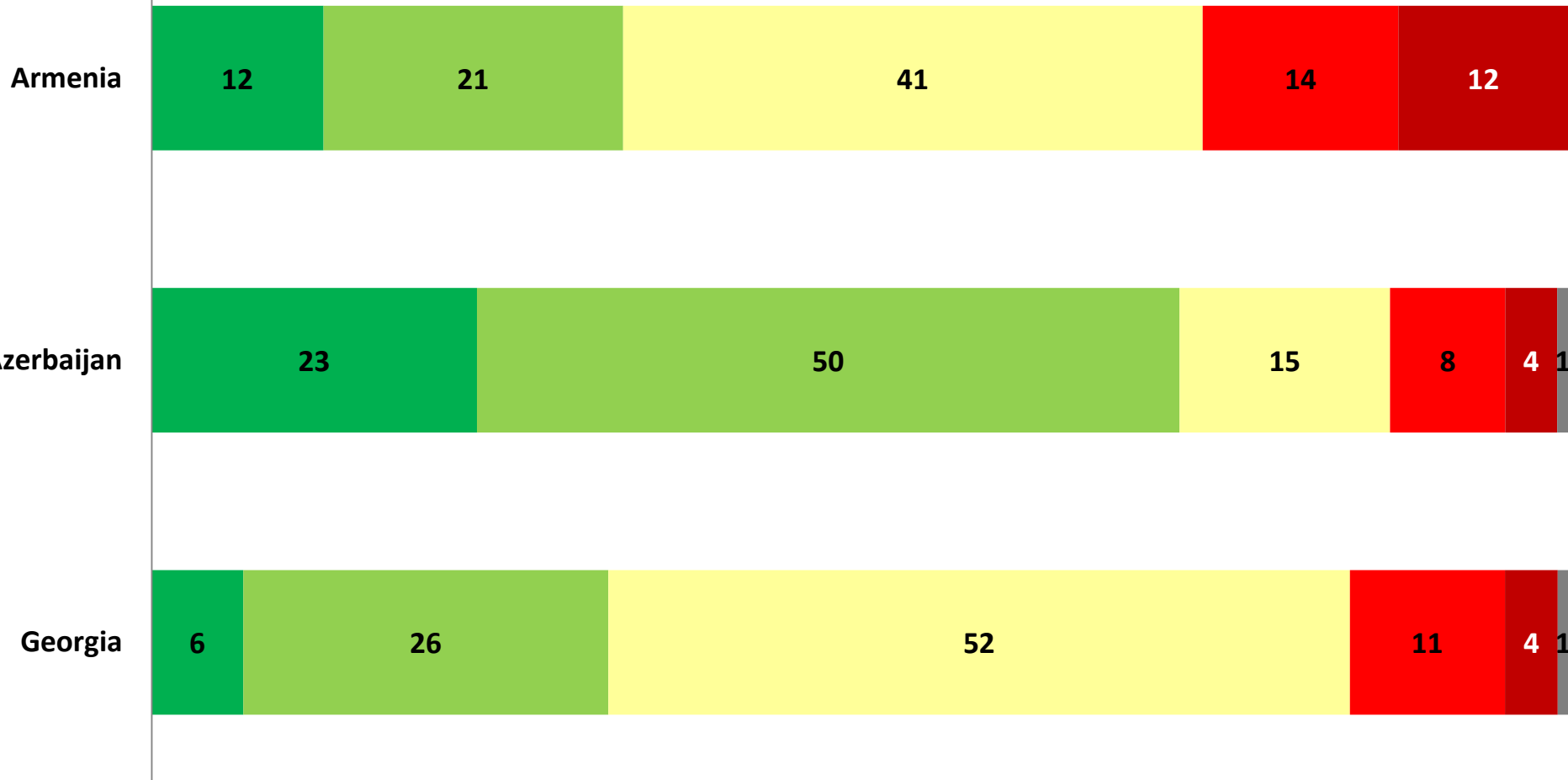

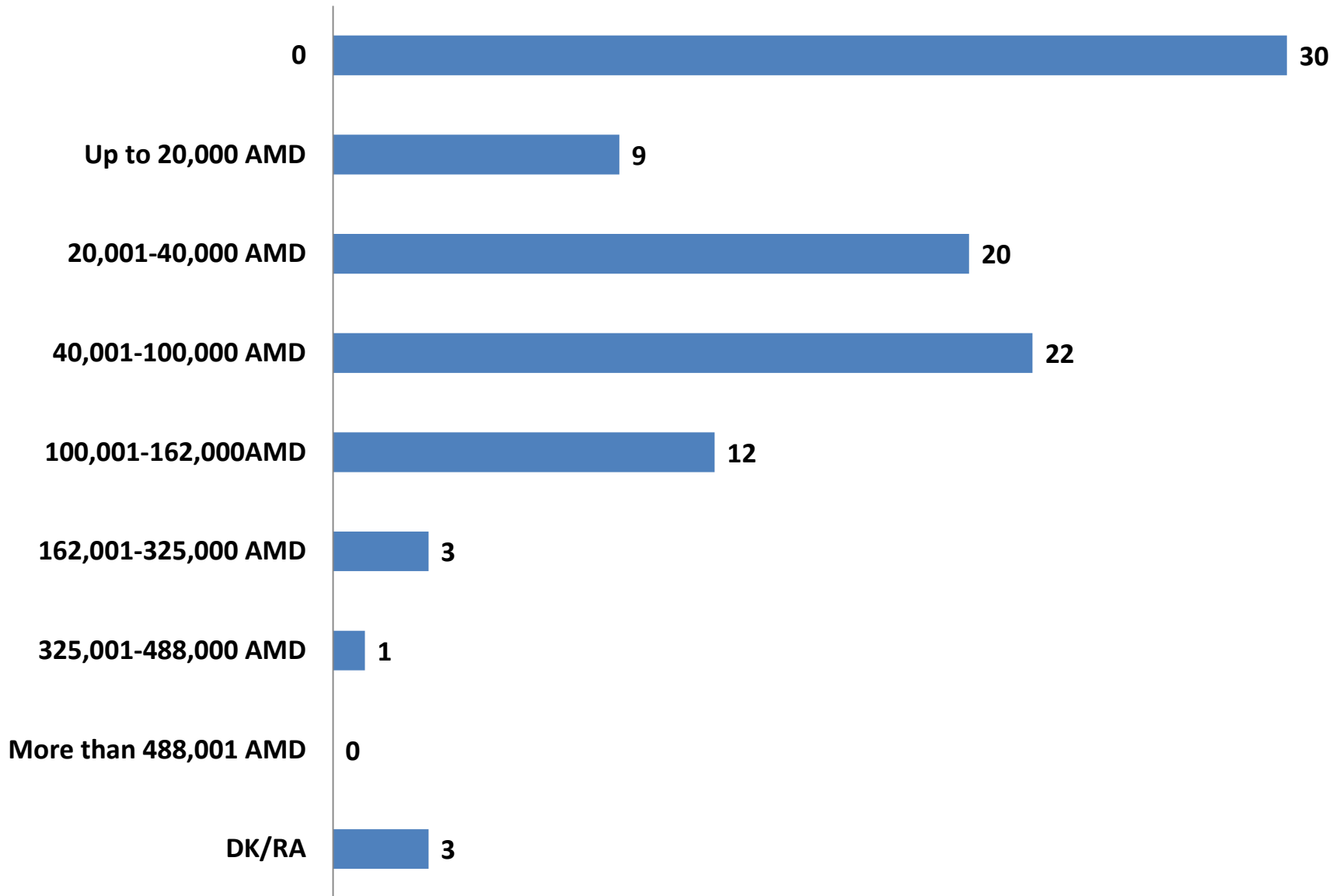


**J10. Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your job?

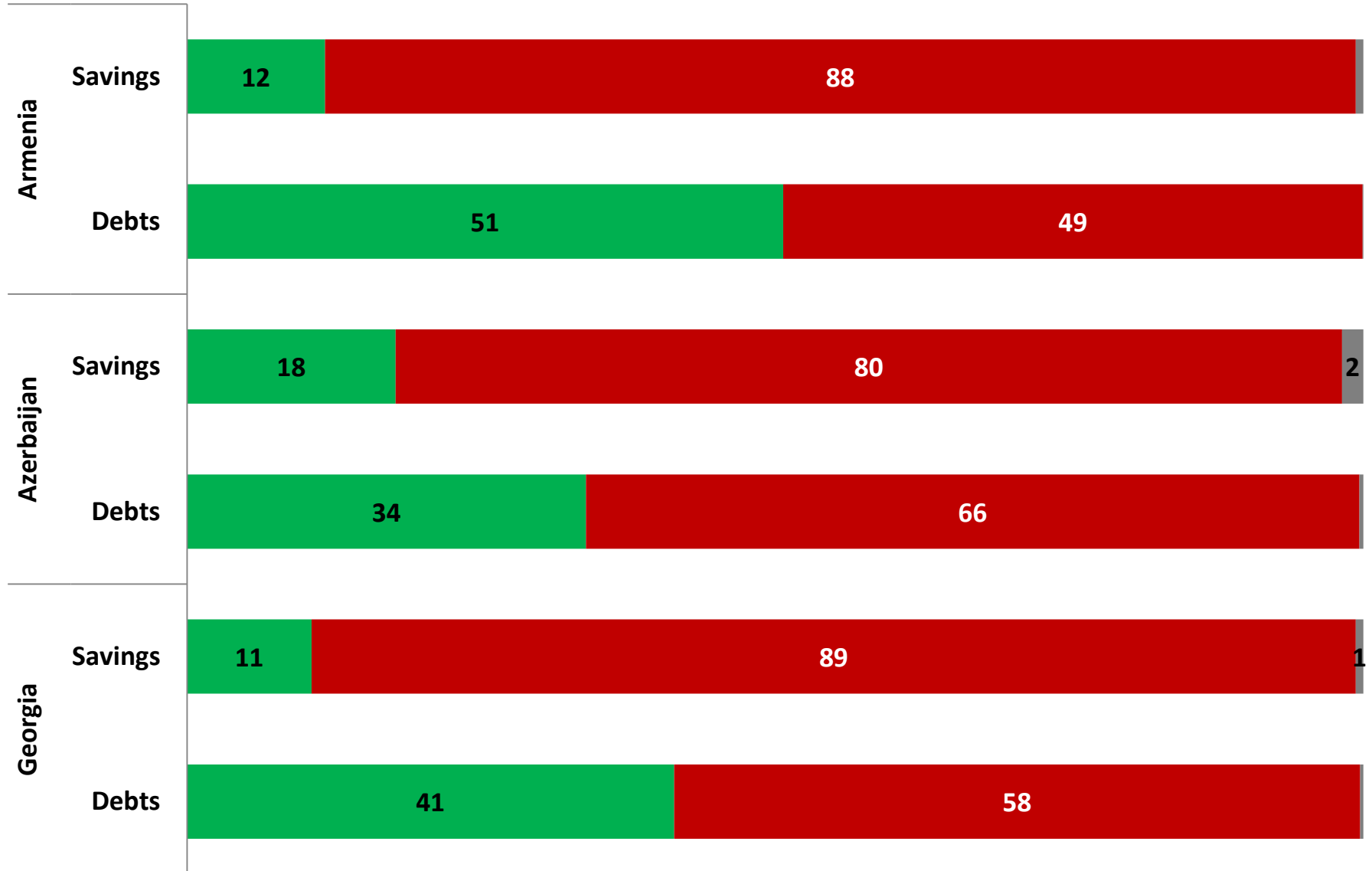

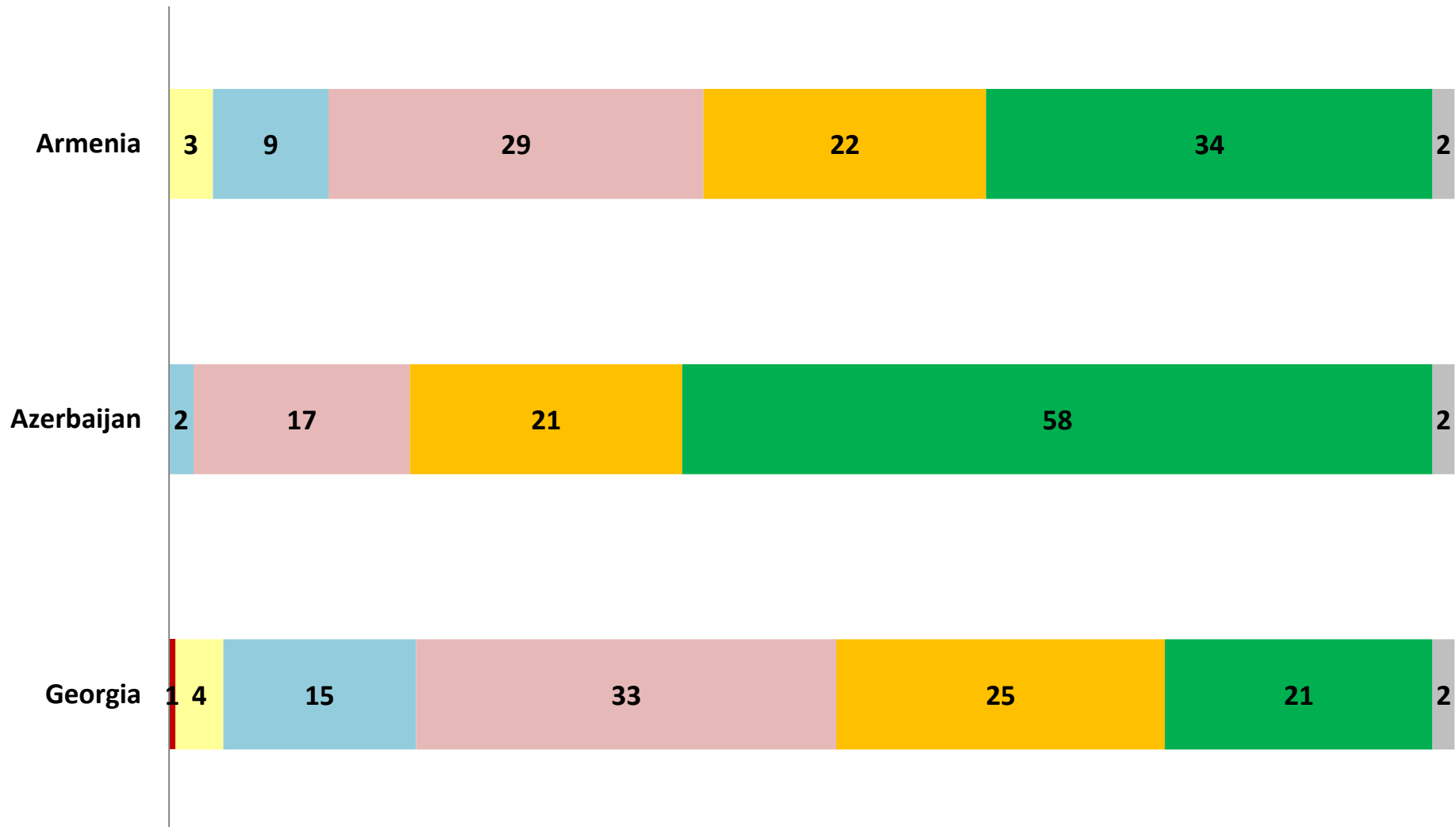
J13-J14. Do you currently have any personal savings or debts? (%)

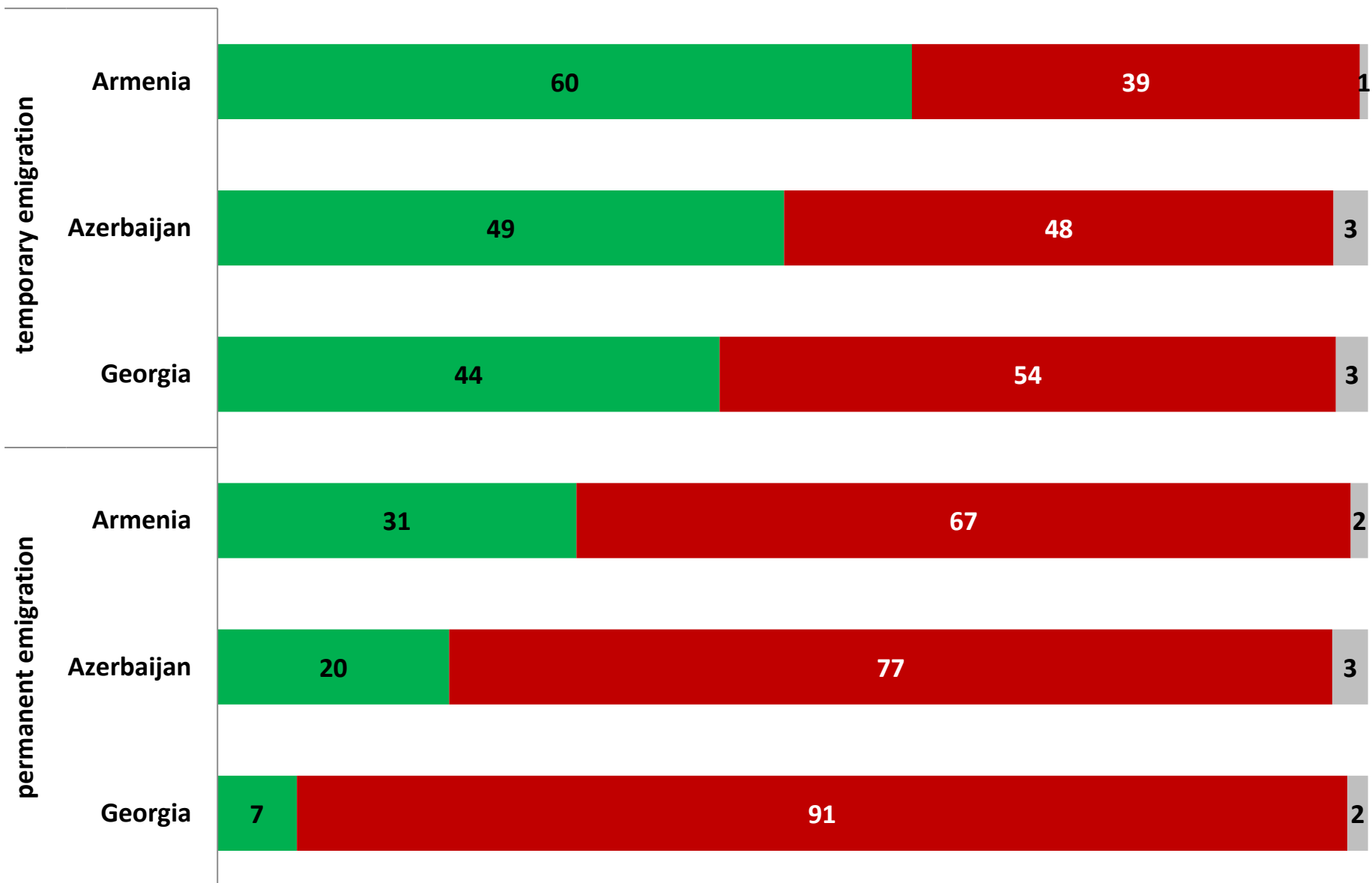
C13. Minimal monthly income for normal life (%) CB2013

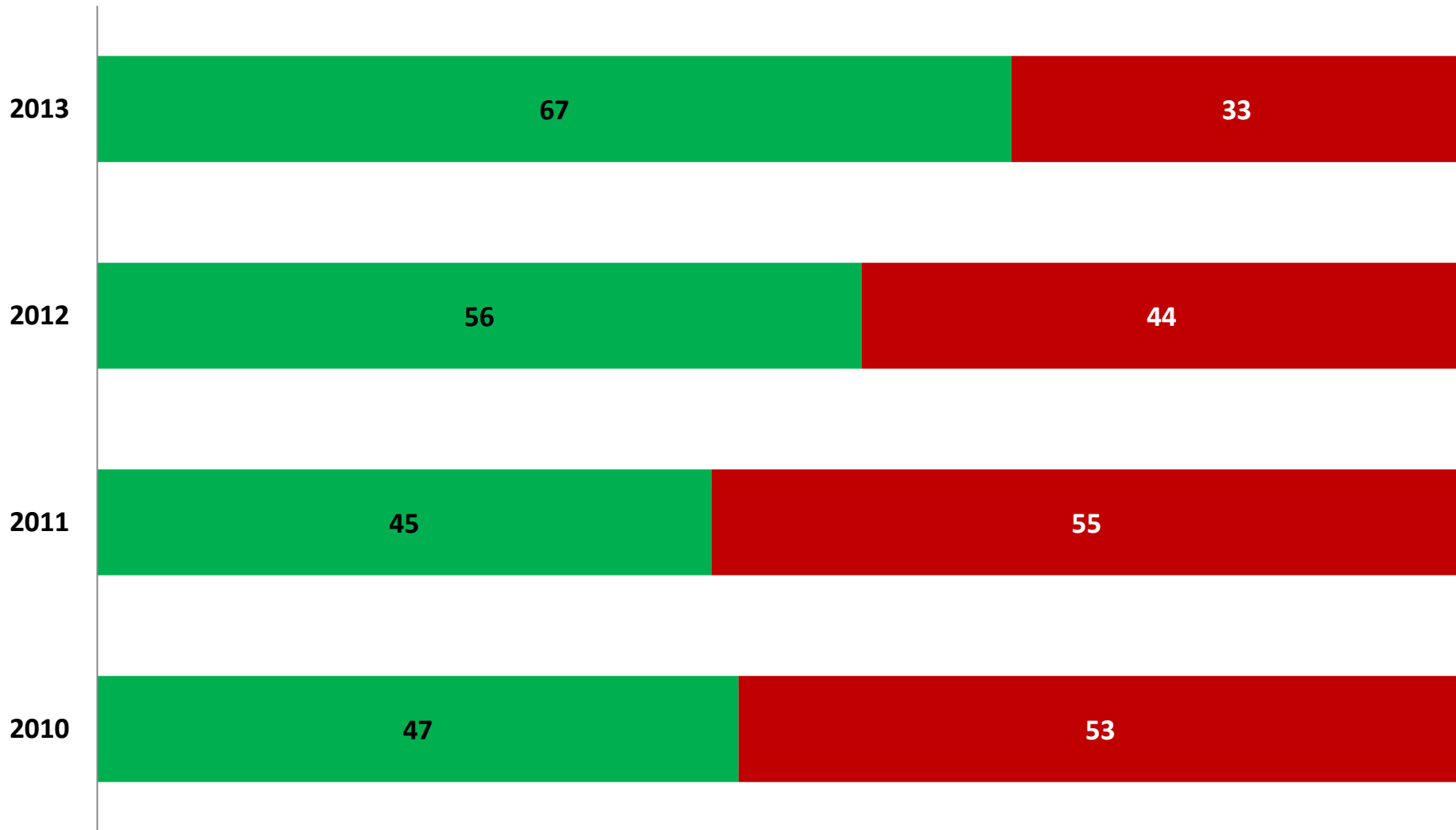

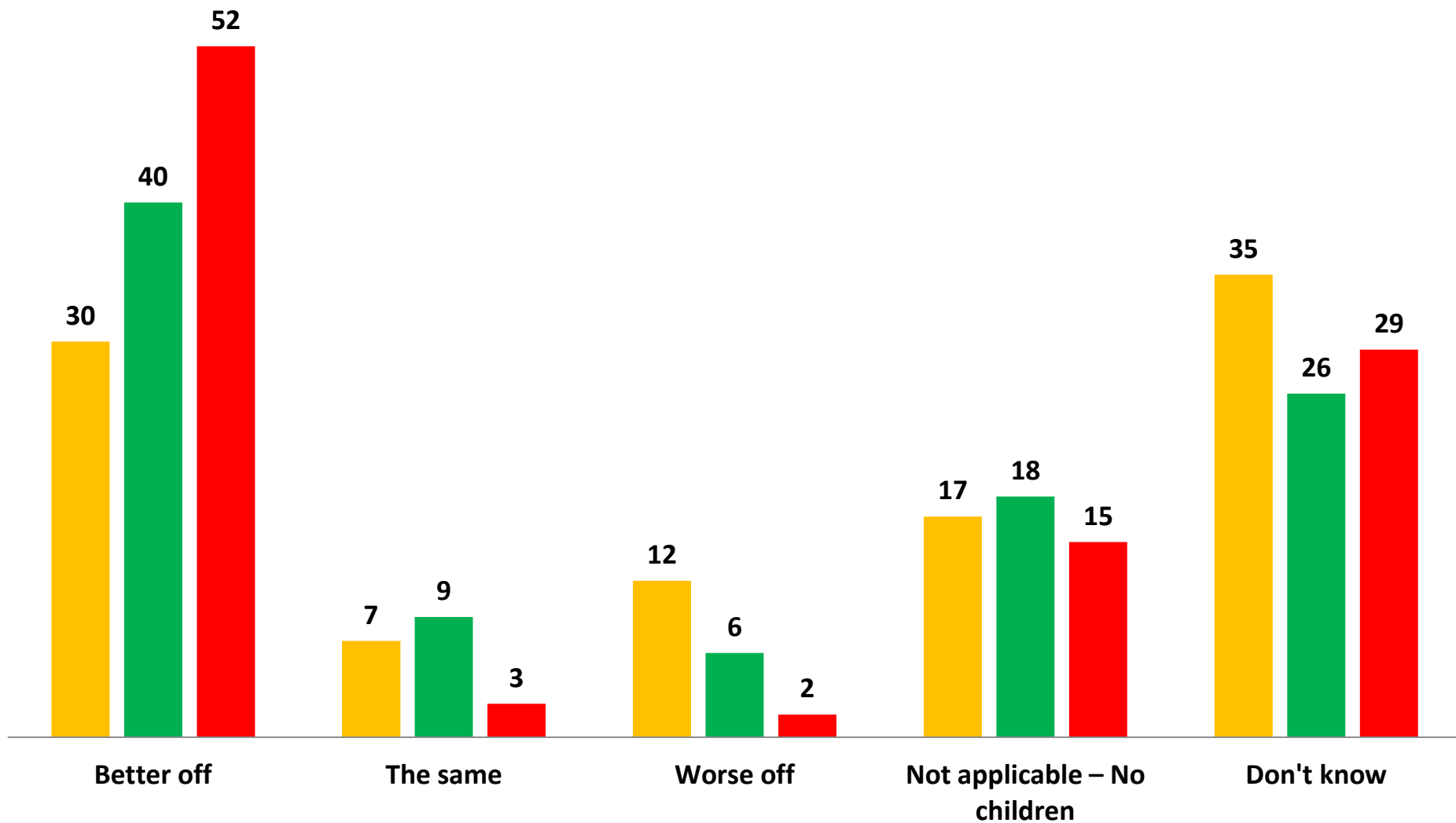

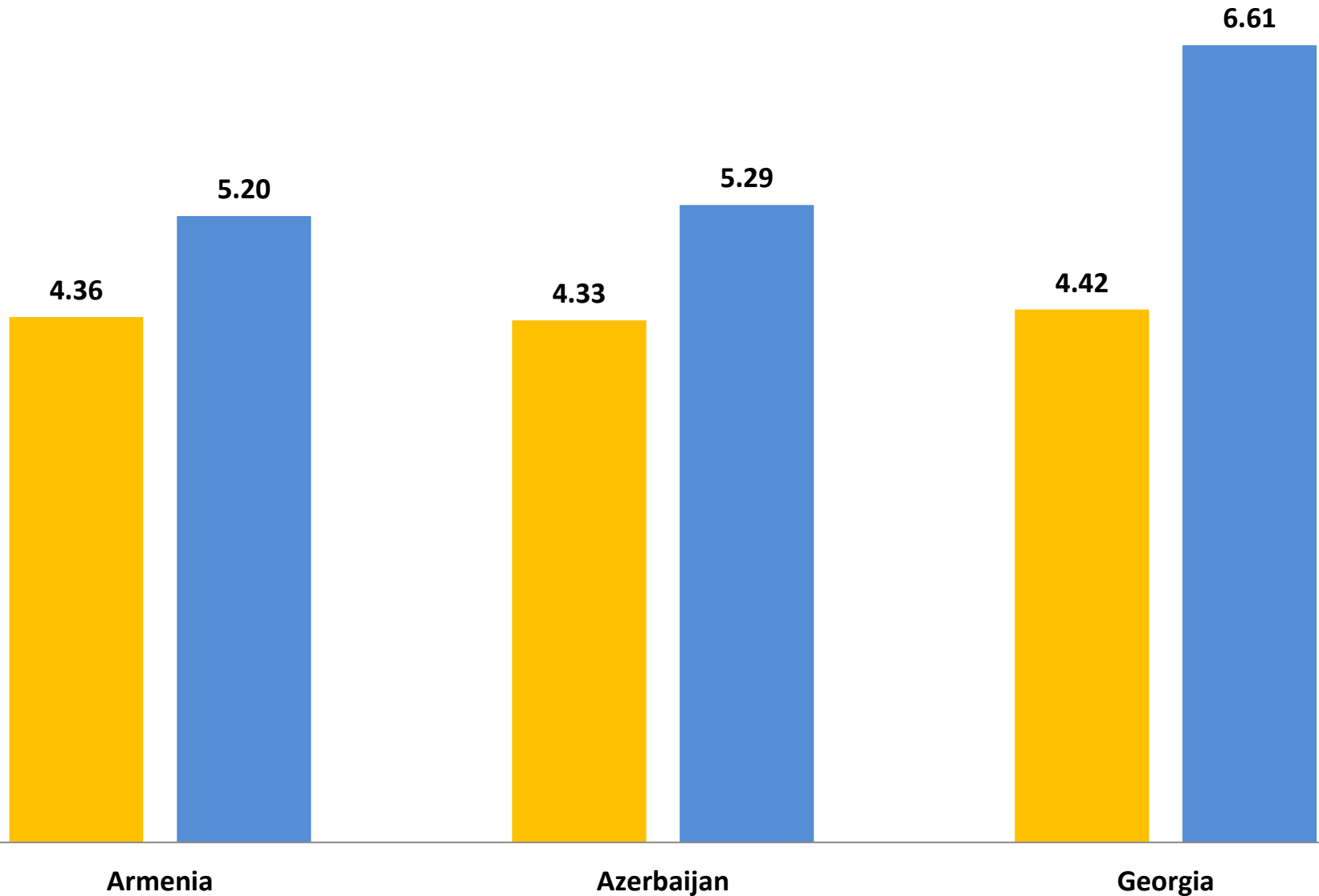

C10-C11. Households economic rung (average score, 10-point scale, where '1' is the lowest stage and 10 is the highest)

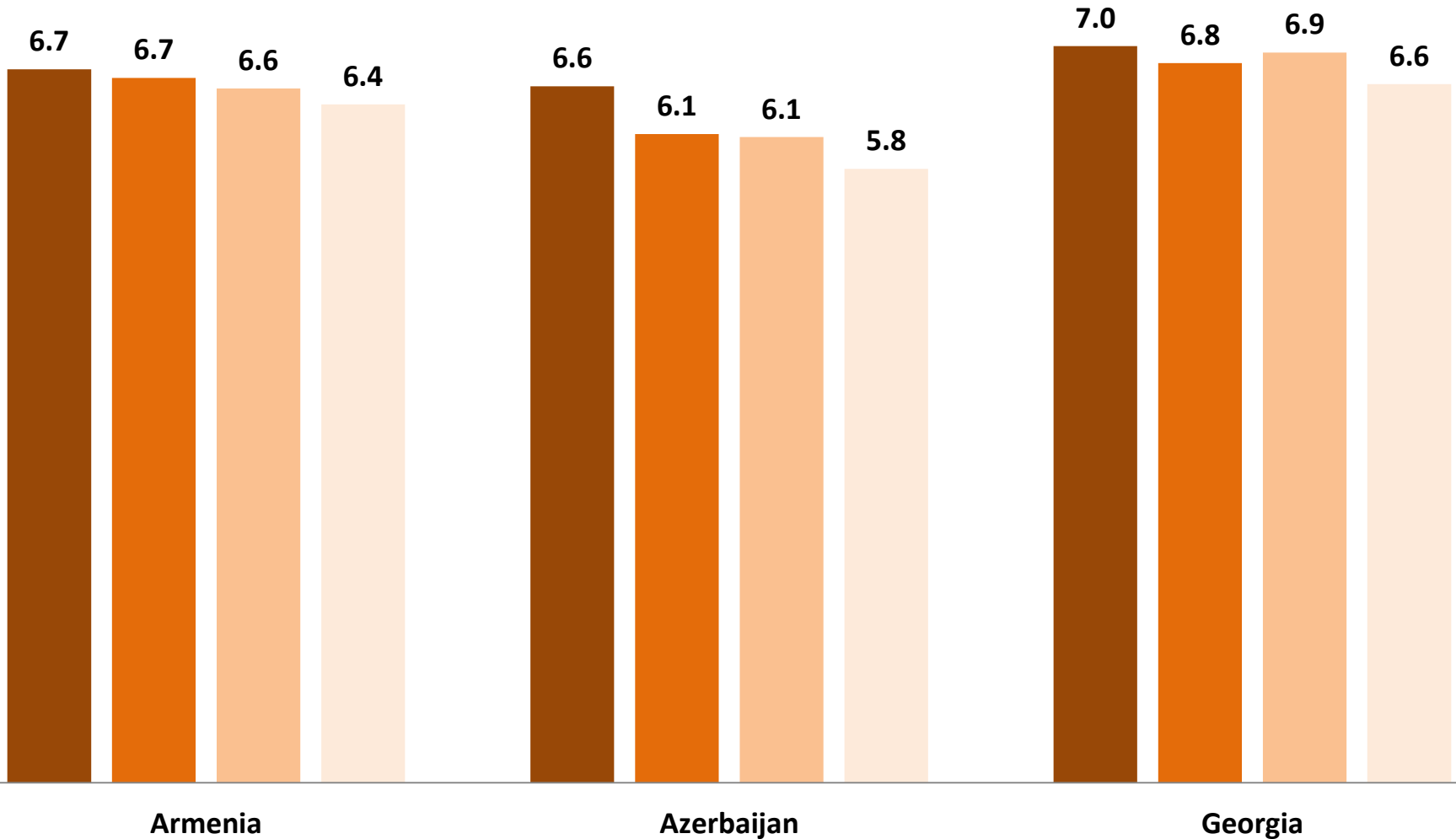

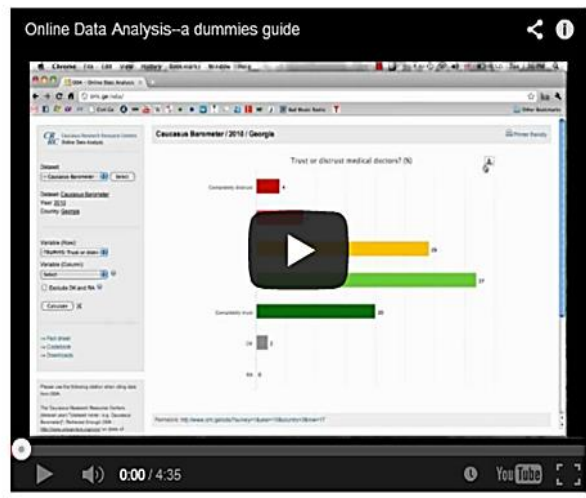
