Project Framework

A qualitative study to explore the attitudes and perspectives towards sex imbalances through:

- * focus group discussions,
- * life stories and
- * key informant interviews

in four communities in Armenia

Geographic Coverage (population in 000s, 2011 Census data)

Gender Discrimination Patterns

- Research team members didn't expect the Boy Preference issue to be so deep and widespread in the Armenian society
- Women get discriminative messages concerning their gender
- Women get discriminative messages concerning their role to give birth to a boy (from family members, doctors, others, etc.)
- Dowry for girls, Inheritance for boys

Gender Discrimination Patterns (cont'd)

- Mother-in-law has strong impact on decision-making concerning abortions
- Attitude toward daughters changes among Elderly:
 "Daughters usually help, support and take care for the oldaged parents"
- High level of awareness on contraception methods among youth even in remote communities

Attitude towards Abortion

- Crucial change in attitude toward abortion
 - Elderly women reported up to 30 and more abortions during lifetime.
 - Young women ashamed of reporting abortions
 - Young women don't tolerate abortions
 - Socio-economic situation in the country does not favor high level of fertility

Feedback on Expert Interviews

- Low level of awareness on the issue among Key Informants during the research
- The attitude toward selective abortion among Doctors varies. It is very individual. Some accept it as a family planning mechanism
- Respondents report on gender aspect of inheritance cases. "Good daughters shouldn't demand their share of the inheritance".
- The idea to forbid the abortions is unacceptable
